168 PRIME CATTLE

The cattle trade has stopped slipping with only the cattle that are out of specification not seeing an improvement in prices – that is not to say that demand is great but we will live to fight another day! Bull trade probably saw the greatest improvement but with the poorest sample of bulls possibly ever seen in the market. This is why our overall average was 181p/kg.

Best steers sold to 241p/kg and sold to £1566 in the lump. There were very few steers that were ideal with many over 750kg and non-assured.

Butchers heifers were not as sharp as we have seen but still sold to 258p/kg or £1516 as a whole. There were some small thick cattle which looked cheap in the 150 and 160 pence's but few bidders for these.

21 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL SOLD TO OV. AV. 108P/KG

Cow trade saw a marked improvement with cows 5-10p/kg dearer than recent sales.

634kg Limousin sucklers sold to 133p/kg with 702kg Charolais to 128p/kg. Meat Friesians sold to 116p/kg for 752kg. Plain cows were much dearer with some passed 80p/kg to 86p/kg. Blonde stock bulls 742kg sold to 110p/kg.

MORE COWS NEEDED NEXT WEEK

115 CLEAN CATTLE

20 steers sold to an overall average of 196p/kg. Bullocks sold well above deadweight quotations once again to 241p/kg for 512kg Simmentals from Ray Bason. British Blues from Peter Raybould achieved 218p/kg for 652kg, with 566kg Lims to 215p/kg from Alastair Beedles. 746kg Blondes hit 210p/kg from Tony Williams (£1566.20). Black and white Herefords to 175p/kg for Steve Lewis.

95 heifers sold to an overall average of 198p/kg. A cracking run of Limousins from Richard Parkes sold to 258p/kg (x2) all above 500kg. 490kg Lims from Matt Bower sold to 248p/kg with Dave Chilton and Brain Watkins selling Lims and Blondes respectively to 247p/kg. Heavy heifers sold to £1516 from Mr Williams.

53 YOUNG BULLS SOLD OV AV. 144P/KG

41 bulls were either Holstein, Friesian or Ayshire this morning. Large numbers were ultra-plain both under and over 16m of age. Charlie Lloyd's Blonde and Limousin crosses sold to 206p/kg and 200p/kg for 552kg and 536kg. British Blues from Graham Barker at 582kg sold to 191p/kg, with Dave Meddins' Simmentals selling to 187p/kg for 624kg.

Holsteins met a much stronger trade with 612kg selling to

170p/kg from James Woolrich, with several meated sorts above 160p/kg.
