A similar trade with very best handy weight cattle in shorter supply, with more wholesaling cattle forward generally. With more commercial types penned this morning averages undoubtedly reflected this fact with heifers averaging 8p/kg less generally.

Steer averages were fair with many Herefords forward. Strong demand on best quality to 214p/kg or £1,340 in the lump.

Butchers heifers met a consistent trade to 253p/kg with more heifers in the 230 pence's than the 240 pence's. Commercial breakers met an 'easier' trade but held up well throughout the sale.

Bull trade was pleasing with all shapes and sizes wanted. Shapely Continentals sold to 219p/kg and Holsteins to 175p/kg.

12 COWS FORWARD SOLD TO OV.AV.103P/KG

Great to see a few more cows with trade requiring more. No real humdingers penned saw Limousin crosses to 119p/kg for 784kg and Angus crosses to 118p/kg. 860kg Holsteins sold well with little shape to 113p/kg. Buyers requesting more cows each week – do not venture onto the dark side on a rising trade!

A useful run of homebred Limmies from Gordon and Chris Jones topped here at 214p/kg for 602kg with another to 205p/kg. 670kg Limousin's from Brian and Dave Whiteman sold to 196p/kg with Alastair Beedles similar quality and type to the same. Hereford crosses to 178p/kg from Phil Terry, with Shorthorns to 173p/kg from John Cantrill.

74 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 197P/KG

Handy weight 462kg Limmies from Richard Parkes were in the limelight at 253p/kg, closely followed by 512kg Blondes at 247p/kg from 'Mrs B'. Several more in the 230 pence's from the Parkes family, with Dave Jones selling 512kg Limousin crosses to 231p/kg. 636kg Limmies to £1,335 from Frank Davenport.

45 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 175P/KG

Great to see a few more bulls forward and a good trade throughout. British Blues from Ed Green took top spot at 219p/kg for 620kg with handy weight Blondes to 210p/kg at 466kg from John Cantrill. 662kg Limousin's sold to 207p/kg from John Hewitt, with his other 734kg bull to £1,394.60 in the lump.

A great result on the Black and White section saw Holsteins to 175p/kg from James Woolrich, with Friesians to 170p/kg from Charlie Lloyd. Strong buyer demand in this department.

Nationally numbers are well down, a combination of storms and condition, but numbers in Bridgnorth up almost 50% on last week and well in front of this week last year.

Normally the expectation would be an easier trade with a large entry, however that was not the case, averaging 242p/kg against 180p/kg this week last year, even with several pens of overfat or out of spec hoggs forward.

Remarkably 285p/kg was the top price on no less than three occasions for 40.5kg to 45kg Texels and a top price per head of £135.60 from Richard Morgan. Very average but heavy Suffolk lambs at £129.60. Rows of 46kg to 50kg were £120 plus. Every single 39kg to 45kg hogg averaging £104.40 and hoggs 45kg to 51kg averaging £115 and the over 52kg's averaged an unbelievable £125.

Lighter weight hoggs 35kg to 250p/kg, Beltex and Hill sheep 30kg to 233p/kg with Swales at 220p/kg.


