#### **162 PRIME CATTLE**

A much improved entry with more prime cattle out yesterday also. Trade was slightly easier, especially on the better sorts — there were more well-fleshed cattle, especially heifers forward. Wholesalers and butchers were reporting a fairly flat trade but hoping for more business over Easter.

More steers penned but very limited quality. Ultra-lean Bazadaise steers sold to 212p/kg, with Limousins to £1229 in the lump. Holstein steers to £1158.

Handy-weight butchers heifers sold to a high of 246p/kg, with heavier heifers to £1282.

Bull trade was sharp with all types in strong demand. Sucklers sold passed 220p/kg to a top price of 227p/kg and £1335 in the lump. There were some very tidy black and whites about selling to 211p/kg.

#### 10 COWS SOLD TO AV. 93P/KG

More cows but lacking those best types. 734kg Limousins sold to 146p/kg (£1072), with meated Friesian/Holsteins to 133p/kg for 692kg. 512kg Jerseys sold to 78p/kg. Non-assured cows that were very plain not very valuable.

#### **104 CLEAN CATTLE**

**21 steers sold to average 174p/kg** – Bazadaise steers from a "very deserving cause" sold to 212p/kg at 510kg. Two Blondes from Martin Osborne both achieved 201p/kg for 540kg and 576kg, with Limousins to 197p/kg from David & Brian Whiteman (£1229). Friesian steers 686kg sold to £1158 from Phillip Clarke.

**83** heifers sold to av. 202p/kg – A good run from Richard Parkes took the headline at 246p/kg with others to 240p/kg and 237p/kg. John Griffiths, Roger Jordin and Mrs B all sold to 230p/kg. Some well-meated females penned today and a bit of belly!

#### 58 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 186P/KG

A smashing lot from Rob & Peter Hartley took most of the plaudits selling from 218p/kg to a high of 227p/kg at 588kg. Brian Watkins' Blondes sold to 222p/kg for 566kg, with Andrew Preece selling his Limmies to 216p/kg, 219p/kg and 220p/kg. Paul Taylor's better than average "Friesians" sold to 211p/kg and 188p/kg, with Colin Evans' Holsteins in town selling to 180p/kg for 552kg.
