Good numbers forward once again met an easier trade, with some price resistance experienced at the moment not helping sales. Best butchers cattle still sold to advantage. Several very small cattle forward today with those falling below 400kg more difficult to place.

Only a small entry of steers saw handyweights to 255p/kg, with heavies to 240p/kg or £1545.50 in the lump.

Butchers heifers sold to a high of 292p/kg with another to 290p/kg. Heavy females topped at £1652.

Some super quality bulls forward saw trade firm to high of 248p/kg or £1835 in the body. Plain Holsteins met a difficult trade with these a day too late for the Muslim festivals.

#### Only 8 STEERS SOLD TO OV.AV. 219P/KG

Andrew Bishop stole all the plaudits here selling his 456kg Limmie steer to 255p/kg. Heavy Limousin crosses at 644kg sold to 240p/kg from Ted Rogers (£1545.60), with James Griffin selling his Limousin to 230p/kg for 636kg.

#### 93 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 219P/KG

Two homebred Limmies from the Bishop stable sailed to 292p/kg + 290p/kg for 488kg and 494kg respectively. A 504kg Lim from Rhys and Steve Perkins took third spot at 285p/kg. Evans (Curdale) sold their best to 279p/kg for 528kg, with Mrs 'B' selling her Lim cross to 269p/kg for 490kg. Heavy females sold to £1652.44 and £1603.14 both from Chris Jones, with Dave Bradley selling to £1520.48.

#### 55 BULLS SOLD TO OV.AV. 204P/KG

A sprinkling of exceptional bulls today saw a great result with Steve Davies selling 608kg Lims to 249p/kg. A superb trio from Jane and Robin Edwards topped at 248p/kg with their heaviest to £1835.16 for 746kg. Glynn Powell also sold his Blonde cross to 248p/kg for 664kg. Rob Hartley and Dan Watkins both achieved 247p/kg with Mulberry Homes again selling to 246p/kg. Fit Holsteins were few and far between with Colin Evans selling to 200p/kg for 526kg. No trade on Black and Whites without meat due to the Muslim trade being switched off this morning.

Much larger numbers presented in auction this week up over 50% nationally and surprisingly hoggs numbers also up on last week by almost 40%.

Together with the forthcoming festival of Eid towards the end of the week, customers seem awash with sheep and as a result trade nationally has eased.

This said a very respectable average of 335p/kg, with the best lambs to 359p/kg and £164.65. With Ben Rochelle's consignment of lambs averaging just over £150 per head.

Regardless of last week's exceptional average of 370p/kg, the spring lamb trade has been nothing short of exceptional and for the long term good of the trade needs to realign. All customers in Europe are now looking for cheaper alternatives to our lamb and without these customers to take volume, the long term prospects could be hard work. Light weight lambs of 30kg to 34kg, trading around 340p/kg. Butchers lambs 345p/kg to 335p/kg and heavier 43kg + lambs 325p/kg to 335p/kg.

Far too many plain lambs, which on a stricken trade proved hard work.

Generally and probably due to the grass situation, the trade on couples seem a little easier although still plenty of interest in all sheep to graze.


