### 139 PRIME CATTLE

Short of numbers with a fresh face for bulls and heifers around the ring. Best quality sorts that were well-finished saw a buoyant trade throughout. There were several second quality types and many cattle over 30 months including some over 48 months. These sold well if they had meat on but averages would be depleted somewhat.

Very short of good bullocks saw best Continentals to 214p/kg. 45 month bullocks sold to £1565 with Farm Assurance essential on these.

More heifers above 240p/kg to a high of 247p/kg. Heavier females sold to £1338 but not 600kg.

Bull trade stayed firm with reports of cheaper bulls about in some markets. Shop bulls to 226p/kg, with heavy bulls 18m selling to £1552.

**12 COWS SOLD TO OV. AV. 92P/KG** A useful trade with lots of plain boners and steakers forward, with no Farm Assured suckler cows penned at all. 860kg meaty Friesians sold to 135p/kg (a real result as she was fat enough!). Steakers to 114p/kg. Young Limousin slips to 135p/kg for 538kg.

### 87 CLEAN CATTLE

**Only 15 Steers sold to ov.av. 164p/kg** – Matt & Wendy Bower's Lims and Blondes topped this department at 214p/kg and 208p/kg respectively with 680kg Limousin crosses to 185p/kg from Phil Clarke. Mr Bibbey's over-agers sold well but were good meat and saw 954kg Limousin crosses to £1564.56 for 45 months, with Holsteins to £1474.56 for 1024kg at 45 months also.

**72 Heifers sold to ov.av. 204p/kg** – Rich Parkes was encouraged to bring extra today and was well-rewarded selling to 247p/kg, with 14 heifers averaging 236p/kg or £1260, with his heaviest to £1337.92 (592kg). Two crackers from Henry Yates sold to 244p/kg and 243p/kg, with Simon Jones selling to 241p/kg.

Many pens well over the £100 mark, with 48.5kg from Andrew Preece selling just short of £113. Brian Williams, Shipton, to £110.39 and Tony Davies just below £110 for 50.5kg. A black lambs from Roger B sold 58kg to £109.62. Lighter lambs harder work, with only the sweetest past 200p/kg, with 34kg-38kg a fair trade around 205p/kg-215p/kg.
