53 PRIME CATTLE

Very short of cattle today as producers show concern about the negative price indications being sent out from the large supermarket abattoirs and vote with their feet. The live auction defied gravity once again with a sharp trade from start to finish. The super yard of cattle was a credit to all farmers who got their just rewards.

15 cattle sold to 300p/kg and above with heifers selling to a high of 348p/kg on two occasions with heavy females to £1943 in the lump.

Only 3 steers saw a high of 282p/kg for Angus steers at £1624 in the lump.

Bull numbers were sadly lacking and trade was no worse but could have been helped by a few more numbers. Continentals sold to 268p/kg.

10 cull cows met a fair trade but with a cool breeze imminent it seems. No best cows forward but Charolais cross cows topped at 168p/kg for 786kg.

45 CLEAN CATTLE

ONLY 3 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 268P/KG

'Mrs B' owned all the steers today and sold her useful Angus to 282p/kg for 576kg with her Blue Friesian to 274p/kg for 516kg.

42 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 292P/KG

A good run from Evans, Curdale saw his two best Red Limmies sail to 348p/kg for 530kg and 536kg with two similar weights to 345p/kg and another to 340p/kg. Well meated Blondes from 'Mrs B' sold at 340p/kg with her second best to 330p/kg for 524kg. Harvey Parkes' quality run topped at 330p/kg for 492kg. Bazadise heifers at 572kg sold to 318p/kg from Nigel Fieldhouse with his 670kg Red Limmie to £1943.

8 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 253P/KG

564kg Limousins from Paul 'Wales' Jones sold to a high of 268p/kg with Bill Yeomans' best to 264p/kg.

A very different trade this morning with customers all seemingly having the same problems, that being lamb, both home and abroad, proving hard to sell. Better finished lambs remain easier to sell with customers looking for meat.

A super run of Texel Beltex lambs from Evans, Curdale sold to 310p/kg for 44.5kg averaging just shy of 300p/kg. Heavier lambs attracting interest to 285p/kg for 46.5kg again from Evans, Curdale.

Lambs under 40kg were a mixed trade with meated sheep easier sold to 295p/kg for 36.5kg from Doug Heighway although lightweight, lean lambs harder work.

The usual consignment from Tony Davies sold to a top of £143 for 52kg Texels.

108 STORE CATTLE/COWS & CALVES

Plenty of customers looking for cattle and breeding stock but all trying to buy them more reasonably. Steers were mainly smaller grazing types and sold to £935 for 17 month Blondes from Mr England, with a nice run of Stabiliser steers from Mr Moores selling to £900 at 14-15 months.

British Blue x Holstein heifers sold to £1180 from Mr Taylor at 24 months with others to £965 from the same stable. Smarter heifers very hard to find with Limousins to £930 for 400kg from Mr Taylor. Simmental x bulls from Mr Freeth sold to £795 with his Herefords to £730, all at 12 months old.

The Freeth's Hereford x cows with young Hereford calves (one month) sold to £1150.

Steers averaged 219p/kg to 253p/kg, Heifers averaged 212p/kg to 242p/kg, Bulls to 240p/kg.
