84 PRIME CATTLE

More clean cattle forward saw trade holding its own generally but with far fewer bulls penned this morning. Probably a few more ordinary sorts about, some not quite thick enough meat for some tastes around our ring! It was nice to see a few more cows and stock bulls today also.

Decent steer numbers saw a solid trade throughout. Best quality sold to 284p/kg with OTM steers adding up nicely to £1890.

A small show of heifers saw butchers cattle to 316p/kg with five heifers 300p/kg or above. Heavy females topped at £1764 in the lump.

Bull trade was at least as good as recent weeks with best continentals up to 260p/kg or £1606 in the lump but no heavy bulls penned today. Black and Whites topped at 209p/kg and above £1200.

5 COWS AND 1 STOCK BULL

Young Angus slips (non-assured) sold to 156p/kg for 646kg with aged Blue cows 734kg to 148p/kg. Non-assured Hereford stock bull to £970 in the lump.

66 CLEAN CATTLE

23 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 245P/KG

A great run of Limmies topped here at 284p/kg for 630kg with another to the same at 580kg from Tony Barker and John Cantrill respectively. Tony also sold two others to 280p/kg and 283p/kg. Overage beef Shorthorns from Paul Taylor sold to £1889.64 for 724kg (31 months). British Whites to 254p/kg from 'Mrs B'.

43 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 271P/KG

Starring heifers were from the Parkes stable and sold to 316p/kg and 315p/kg for 516kg and 504kg. Glyn Powell sold his homebred Blondes early doors at 512kg to 306p/kg with Gary and Greg Thomas selling two sharp Limmies to 305p/kg and 301p/kg. 548kg Lims from Evans (Curdale) headed their run at 298p/kg. 598kg Lims added up nicely to £1764.10 (298p/kg) again from the Parkes family.

ONLY 18 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 218P/KG

A good day for Paul Taylor (he might smile!) saw his best Limmie bull sell to 260p/kg for 618kg with 616kg Lims to 259p/kg from Harold and Rob Pugh.

A firmer trade to last week comparing very favourably with other local auctions. Best lambs remain well sold to 276p/kg for 43.5kg lambs from Richard Morgan and heavy lambs to £156 for 70kg lambs from Burwarton Farms.

Trade has remained very static, give or take the odd pen or two, over the past month. High Street sales are becoming very price conscious and the constant news of increasing costs are syphoning back down the supply chain.

Heavy lambs remain well sold with lambs over 45kg averaging just shy of £120.

Lambs under 40kg to 240p/kg for 38kg lambs with increasing demand for the lighter lamb.

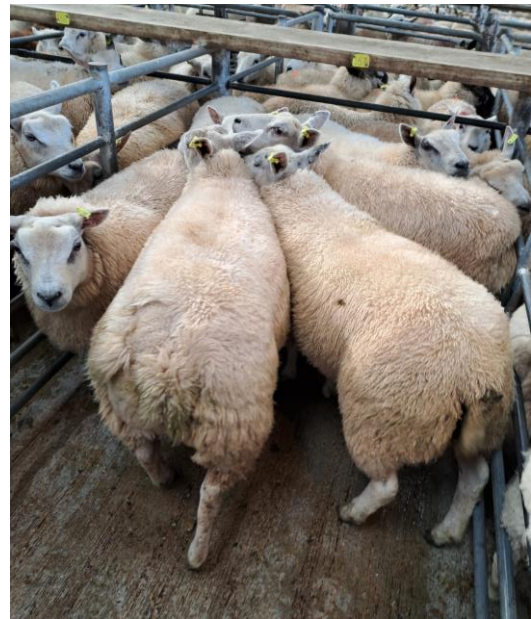
