129 PRIME CATTLE

Trade continues to improve with some Christmas trade beginning to help orders. More cattle could have easily sold to advantage today with the whole market selling to average 181p/kg including young cows and over agers in the clean section.

A few more steers forward today sold to 226p/kg for Continentals or £1435.20 per head. Butchers cattle in strong demand selling to a high of 254p/kg for heifers with a nice sprinkling of quality types to help fulfil orders.

The bull entry was disappointing both in number and quality. There were hardly any suckler bred

20 COWS SOLD TO AV. 93P/KG

Cow trade held its own today with fit young British Blues selling to 139p/kg for 648kg from Mrs Sutton. Charolais meat cows to 127p/kg for 848kg from Mr Beaman. Friesian cows to 107p/kg from Mrs Bomford. Ultra-plain cows would have been better fed in some cases!

86 CLEAN CATTLE

18 steers sold to av. 181p/kg – A nice run from Gordon Jones took all the honours with 546kg Limousins to 226p/kg with others to 214p/kg and 211p/kg. British Blues at 666kg and 736kg sold to 200p/kg and 195p/kg from Phillip Terry. Heavy bullocks to £1435 for 820kg Montbeliarde from Terry Bebb. Herefords off grass to 170p/kg from Mrs Bomford.

68 Heifers sold to average 205p/kg – There were some decent shaped heifers on a place or two today, with Richard Parkes taking the limelight with his 468kg Limousin selling to 254p/kg. 554kg Limousins from David Preece sold to 249p/kg (£1380). Both Jean Kirkham and Roger Jordin sold to 239p/kg for 562kg and 516kg respectively. 512kg Limousins sold to 237p/kg from Peter Raybould. Second quality sorts generally met a dearer trade also.

43 YOUNG BULLS OV. AV. 157P/KG

A very mixed bag of bulls forward and as previously stated, hardly any suckler bred bulls penned.

Limousin crosses 546kg sold to 196p/kg from Frank Povall with Dave Chilton's bogus Holstein also to 196p/kg for 590kg. Julian Aston's 612kg Limmie sold to 186p/kg.

Holsteins sold to 175p/kg from Colin Evans closely followed by Frank Povall's 546kg Friesian at 174p/kg. Rob Stubbs also sold to 174p/kg for 602kg Holsteins.
