Good entries of clean cattle coupled with a small bull entry saw an easier trade with only the very best clean cattle holding values in line or perhaps dearer than last week. More commercial sorts proved hard work, with only well-finished Holstein Friesian bulls seeing any sort of demand. With all the major supermarket suppliers dropping their prices again this week as producers continue to market numbers to reduce winter feed bills nationally.

No top notch steers forward saw Continentals selling to 213p/kg, with heavies to £1328. Well-finished steers easiest placed.

A useful heifer entry sold to 250p/kg on two occasions with several in the 240p/kg or more bracket. Heavy females to £1361.

Best bulls were definitely less money with shapey Lims to 212p/kg, with only two others passed 200p/kg. Black and whites saw similar values to recent sales with the best available passed 170p/kg.

<u>**2 COWS</u>** sold to a high of 97p/kg for British Blues from Mike Davies, with slightly plainer sorts to 85p/kg.</u>
