#### **119 PRIME CATTLE**

Improved numbers of clean cattle which was great to see but bull numbers were sadly lacking, with all our regular buyers needing bulls. A firm trade throughout with a better show of butchers beasts than last week's deficit.

Less steers saw trade holding its own with heavy bullocks selling to 215p/kg or £1462 in the lump.

Best heifers sold to 254p/kg, with three others reaching 246p/kg. Heavy females to £1337.

Suckler bulls sold to 215p/kg on two occasions, with heavies to £1436. Good meated black and whites still in strong demand selling to 171p/kg, with few below 160p/kg. Bulls over 16 months of age no problem to sell in the red market; as long as they were meat!

#### 15 COWS SOLD TO OV. AV. 104P/KG

Cow trade firming, especially on cows with bit of size and meat. Limousins sold to 141p/kg for 654kg and to £1064 in the lump. Montbeliardes to 110p/kg for 746kg. Buyers for stock bulls left empty-handed.

#### **83 CLEAN CATTLE**

**18 Steers sold to ov.av.192p/kg** – Best shapes sold to 215p/kg for 680kg Blues from Rob Foxall and 580kg Limmies from Alastair Beedles. Two more from the Beedles stables sold above 200p/kg, with other Limousins from the Whiteman Bros to 199p/kg for 630kg. Well-finished native breed steers met a form trade.

**76 Heifers sold to ov.av. 196p/kg** – Andrew Craig's superstar Limmie headed the honours board at 254p/kg for 488kg, with three others to 246p/kg for females around half a ton from Roger Jordin, Steve Perkins and Richard Parkes. Alastair Beedles handy 478kg Limmie sold to 239p/kg, closely followed by Dave Chilton selling 510kg to 238p/kg. 700 Blondes sold to £1337 from Frank Millichamp.

#### 25 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 176P/KG
