WEEKLY REPORT – 12.03.19



140 PRIME CATTLE

A few less clean cattle forward met a very two tier trade, with handy-weight quality cattle seeing improved returns with heavier cattle hard work, especially if over 700kg and/or plain. With the large players continuing to trim values each week, it was not surprising to see some dead-weight supported looking on our trade.

Similar number of steers to last week saw best Continentals selling to 210p/kg. More bullocks over 700kg sold to £1345.68 in the lump.

More handy-weight heifers in string demand despite a general lack of lustre in the beef trade, sold to 253p/kg with three others 240p/kg or more. Heavy females sold just short of £1300.

Bull trade was pretty consistent with last week, with suckler bulls selling to 209p/kg to £1284 in the lump. Plenty of bottom end black and whites reduced averages, with well-finished Friesian Holsteins to 165p/kg.

ONLY 3 COWS FORWARD saw fat Charolais cross cows to 106p/kg for 830kg. Lean, non-assured Park White cows sold to 78p/kg for 608kg.

79 CLEAN CATTLE

17 Steers sold to ov.av.180p/kg – A nice run of 552kg and 610kg Limousins from John Johnstone topped at 210p/kg, with 644kg to 195p/kg from a “deserving cause”. Heavy-weights sold to £1354.68 for 756kg Limousins from Andrew Powell.

62 Heifers sold to ov.av. 197p/kg – The usual quality from Richard Parkes sold to 240p/kg, 246p/kg and 253p/kg, with lighter heifers 460kg-530kg easily sold. 534kg Limmies from Clive Evans sold to 240p/kg, with 546kg British Blues from Richard Morgan to 234p/kg. Handy-weights are adding up to more than heavy heifers at the moment, as long as they are well-finished!

61 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 161P/KG

A nice run from Rob & Pete Hartley saw British Blues around 600kg selling to 209p/kg, with 580kg Limousins to 204p/kg from Bill Rodenhurst. Handy-weight Charolais crosses sold to 201p/kg for 514kg from John Gore.

Charlie Lloyd’s black and white sold to 165p/kg, with Dave Preece selling to 164p/kg.

Heavier hogs around 200p/kg per head dearer unless over 55kg and excessively over fat when prices were discounted.

Top price this week of 228p/kg from Richard Morgan for 41.5kg Texels and 46kg to 226p/kg to £103/head.
