Similar numbers forward this morning but with quality types much shorter in supply when compared to last week. With wholesalers not needing guite as many cattle with Bank Holiday weekend looming, trends were no faster but with well-finished cattle in good demand.

A small sample of steers saw the best selling to 260p/kg with heavies to £1715 in the lump. Heavyweight butcher's heifers were less plentiful and sold to 316p/kg with another to 307p/kg. Shapey heavy finds sold nicely to £1955.

Our sample of bulls lacked the cream today, but still sold to 266p/kg with three others in the 260p/kg with heavy continentals to £2010 in the lump. No best black and whites penned saw Holsteins selling to 206p/kg.

Two cows and 1 stock bull saw a firm trade with stock bulls selling to 148p/kg for 992kg, Charolais-cross with Limousin-cross cows on the fat side to 141p/kg.

Quality reflected in the average of 288p/kg, with alleyway after alleyway of fed sheep, with weights generally higher than some weeks, a reflection of the finish of the sheep.

A shortage of hoggs under 40kg with some ordinary hoggs 34kg to 38kg up and around 290p/kg. With 39kg hoggs to 319p/kg and a market topping 329p/kg for 47kg Texel hoggs from Pete Levi totalling £154.60.

Commercial hoggs showing real improvement up to 45.5kg were as per usual for this time of year when meat sells to a premium. Heavier hoggs remain harder work per kilo, with the last pen of the day from Richie Morgan one of the highlights - 52kg at 270p/kg and 76kg at £182.40. Generally, hoggs over 50kg remaining around £130, with better shaped, well-finished sorts making £140 a head. Lighter weights well sold with 30.5kg hill bred hoggs at 279p/kg.
