178 PRIME CATTLE

A good number of cattle forward with a full contingent of buyers around the ring. Generally an improved trade on the better sorts, with handy-weight and in-specification in strong demand and selling well above dead-weight quotations and other local markets so far this week. However, more commercial sorts and processing cattle still a difficult trade and having to compete with cheap imports and cow beef.

Useful entries of steers took a 5p/kg lift, with best sorts selling above 200p/kg to 218p/kg or £1317 in the lump. It is noticeable that some heavier cattle are now coming to less than the ones that are ticking all the boxes at lighter weights? Butchers heifers sold to a dearer trade to 245p/kg with lean, shapey types the order of the day. Producers need to note that cattle have been in the yards a long time now and are coming thicker than you might realise.

More best quality bulls were penned this morning helping overall averages, but also selling well in front of the competition. Two sucklers sold to 218p/kg with a few more around the £1300 mark. Very few black and whites of any quality with the best to 164p/kg and 163p/kg.

ONLY 13 COWS SOLD TO AV.114P/KG

Once again, trade held up well here, with more numbers needed to get orders started. British Blue crosses 758kg sold to 127p/kg for Robert Beaman, with Bill Yeoman's' Blonde cross to 126p/kg. 840kg Simmentals sold to £1058 from David Meddins.
