Definitely a little more 'bite' in the trade, with clean cattle and cows seeing decent demand. Bull trade seems to be suffering at the moment, with abattoirs stockpiling certain cuts which would find their way into the catering or restaurant trade and/or would normally supply the schools.

Some decent steers forward which sold to 236p/kg with two others past 230p/kg. Top price £1439.60 in the lump for bullocks today.

The usual demand on best butchers heifers sold to 259p/kg, with well finished cattle around the 450kg to 540kg easiest sold. Second quality commercial sorts much dearer and in advance of deadweight quotes for this week.

More clean cattle are required at the moment with fresh buying support attending every week. Bull trade was disappointing but nevertheless in line with Monday reports. Best suckler bulls sold to 194p/kg with Holsteins to 155p/kg and Hereford crosses to 160p/kg. Very lean bulls difficult to sell.

10 COWS SOLD TO OV.AV. 120P/KG

Cows have gone in short supply and demand is good with buyers looking for cheaper pence per kilo. Four buyers bidding today. 802kg Blonde cows sold to 147p/kg, with 800kg British Blues to 136p/kg. Friesian cows to 119p/kg for 638kg. MORE COWS NEXT WEEK PLEASE.
