### 128 PRIME CATTLE

#### **Auctioneer – Mark Burgoyne 07831 192603**

There were more bulls penned than clean this morning, with yarded cattle thinning out and grass cattle suffering from the continued wet weather. A fantastic trade resulted on heifers and steers, the best of which were 10-15p/kg dearer than recent sales.

A small entry of steers sold to an improved trade, with quality lacking and bullocks generally on the lean side. The best sold to 212p/kg.

Butchers heifers sold to a sharp trade to 248p/kg, with many more needed to satisfy regular orders.

Bull numbers helped keep the market busy with trade a little dearer but not seeing quite the rise of the clean cattle. Handy-weight sucklers sold to 209p/kg, with black and white meat easiest sold to 167p/kg.

#### **ONLY 10 COWS SOLD TO AV. 101P/KG**

Trade continues to hold up well with more cows slaughtered nationally over recent weeks. Only one suckler cow forward sold to 129p/kg for 606kg British Blue x Holstein, with Friesian steakers to 114p/kg for 622kg. Boning cows were not totally emaciated and sold to 75p/kg.

#### **MORE COWS & STOCK BULLS NEEDED**

#### **ONLY 59 CLEAN CATTLE**

**16 steers sold to av. 186p/kg** – Gordon Jones of Sparchford sold Limousin crosses to 212p/kg for 580kg, with handy-weights to 208p/kg from Brian Whiteman. Rita Corfield sold to 198p/kg and 195p/kg for her Continentals, with Frank Millichamp also achieving 195p/kg for his Blondes.

**43 heifers sold to av. 201p/kg** – A super run from Mrs Edwards sold to 248p/kg, 244p/kg and 238p/kg, all handy-weights. 520kg Limmies from IGC Morris sold to 242p/kg as did British Blues from Steve Perkins for 496kg. 480kg Lims to 239p/kg from Charlie Sandells, with Brian Whiteman achieving the same for two kilos lighter.

#### **MORE CLEAN CATTLE URGENTLY NEEDED**

#### **67 BULLS OV. AV. 168P/KG**

A busy bull section saw well-finished, handy-weight bulls in most demand, both dairy and suckler bred. Blondes from Brian Watkins topped the day at 209p/kg, with Roger Tomley and Harold Pugh closely following at 207p/kg.

Colin Evans sold his run of black and whites to 167p/kg. Friesians from Henry Yates to 165p/kg and 162p/kg.

Good entries of bulls required next week please.

A large entry of lambs and increased buying support, with trade well up on last week averaging 201p/kg to 229p/kg and £104.

Peter Kirton's sold 38kg Texels to 229p/kg and generally the higher prices per kilo for heavier weights, notably 43.5kg at 228p/kg for Stuart Moss whose entry averaged 223.8p/kg and £95 per head.

Several pens realised around £100 to £104 from Peter Levi whose entry averaged £101 for 46.5kg and 218p/kg.

44kg and 48kg lambs sold to 226p/kg for 46kg Charollais and 44kg Texels to 222p/kg for Stuart Moss.

The overall quality of lighter lambs was effected by a large proportion of indoor lambs which sold to 190p/kg for Texel lambs.
