The shortage of cattle continues, with bull numbers suffering today. A firm trade resulted, helped by some well-meated cattle forward. We still had our share of ultra-lean types, which could be placed at a price. Fresh orders for clean cattle today, with regular men finding difficulty filling viable loads.

There were some very useful steers forward this morning, which sold well to 290p/kg or £1`839 in the lump.

Heifers sold to 314p/kg with another 300p/kg with a superb heavy heifer to 296p/kg.

Small numbers of bulls saw a fast trade to a high of 277p/kg or £1776 in the lump with few heavy bulls penned. Holstein bulls sold to 205p/kg.

Five cows sold to a buoyant trade selling to 189p/kg for 804kg Blue cows (£1503.48). Fat Herefords sold to £1389.30 for 842kg.
