131 PRIME CATTLE

Trade carried on from last week showing improvement across the board. A full house of customers ringside including the return of a major bull processor.

Clean cattle average just short of 200p/kg and bulls a vast lift on recent weeks.

11 COWS SOLD TO AV. 130P/KG

Five customers for 11 cows, with 804kg Limousin bulls to 130p/kg and cows to 107p/kg Holsteins, with extremely plain cows all over 60p/kg.

57 CLEAN CATTLE

Steers sold to 226p/kg for 636kg Limousin from IGC Morris with an average of 180p/kg and £1150 including a number over age Friesians realising 132p/kg plus. A number of Continentals 650kg and 27m plus realised 189p/kg to 198p/kg notably 652kg to 198p/kg for Gerald Kincaid and thicker steers 678kg at 190p/kg.

Heifers met an exceptional trade averaging 211.3p/kg. Handy weights selling to 227p/kg twice from Simon Jones and Richard Parkes. Nowhere near enough cattle on offer to meet the strong buying support ringside. A top price this week of 229p/kg for 572kg Limousin also from Ian Morris and 227p/kg Blonde from Dave Preece. Very few heifers under 200p/kg with several ordinary sorts around 480kg at 190p/kg.

74 YOUNG BULLS OV. AV. 150P/KG

The highlight of the day were 74 bulls comprising only 25 Continentals with the remaining two thirds of the entry being black and whites.

Continental bulls to 192p/kg for 514kg superstar from Brian Watkins, with age not reflected in price but worth mentioning with only a handful of bulls under 16 months of age.

Galloway bulls to 182p/kg, Angus 170p/kg and Friesians creating keen competition to 164p/kg for 646kg from Mary Beaumont.

Plainer bulls made up the vast majority of the entry and sold to an improved trade with customers obviously looking to purchase meat regardless of quality to sell on a very price reactive market. Black and whites virtually all over 120p/kg despite several consignments of very challenging models, several looking well sold to 130p/kg plus.


CHARITY AUCTIONEERING COMPETITION
