135 PRIME CATTLE

A decent show of clean cattle but more bulls could have sold to advantage. Some very good quality forward generally but with some cattle lean enough for most tastes. There was a larger show of grass cattle penned this morning. Most steers were on the plain side with best handy-weight Continentals selling to 240p/kg to £1465 in the lump. Some nice butcher's heifers about sold to 250p/kg with numerous females 240p/kg and above. More commercial heifers with meat and finish were always in demand. Too few bulls but some useful sorts about – more Friesians and Holsteins were needed. Best sucklers sold to 231p/kg, Friesians to 182p/kg, Herefords to 205p/kg.

8 COWS met a firm trade with some markets reporting an easier trade with more coming forward. Young Blonde cows sold to 180p/kg for 710kg, with Limousins to 158p/kg for 754kg. Steaking Friesians sold to 115p/kg for 756kg, with non-assured cows considerably discounted.

90 CLEAN CATTLE

24 Steers sold to ov.av. 194p/kg – Blonde steers from Robert Lilley tucked up sold accordingly to 240p/kg for 508kg, with 666kg to 222p/kg. British Blues from John Johnston sold to 214p/kg. 674kg from Phil Clarke sold to £1327.78.

66 Heifers sold to ov.av. 208p/kg – 500kg Limousins from Roger Jordin took top spot at 250p/kg with another to 248p/kg. 248p/kg was also achieved by Richard Parkes and Robert Lilley. Steve Perkins sold to 244p/kg for 494kg with 452kg Limousins to 241p/kg from I & J Evans. 756kg Limousin crosses from Phil Clarke added up nicely to £1421.28.

45 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 186P/KG

3 stormers from Jan Edwards soared away from 222p/kg, 229p/kg to 231p/kg for 502kg to 556kg Limmies. 538kg Blondes from Brian Watkins sold to 226p/kg with 588kg British Blues to 217p/kg from Rob Hartley who also sold to £1348.90 for 658kg British Blues. Mary Beaumont sold her Black & Whites to 182p/kg with another to 181p/kg. James Woolrich's Holsteins sold to £1186.68, with the Powell family selling to £1169.64.

Considerable difference in the price range, 78p/kg from top to bottom, with no surprise lean under finished lambs still proving hard to sell with customers, as the past three months have shown, very keen to purchase finished lambs but avoiding lean bad percenting sheep. Sarah & Stuart Moss took top honours with their entry of 40 lambs selling to 221p/kg. £104 averaging 44kg and 214.5p/kg. Heavy sheep to 208p/kg for 50kg with weight proving no problem this season. Lighter weights to 178p/kg for 34kg and 31kg hill lambs at 179p/kg.
