109 PRIME CATTLE

Short of cattle once again with the resulting flying trade making a very worthwhile result for those producers attending. Buyers however struggled to fill viable loads and well meated cattle were at a marked premium and sold past 300p/kg on several occasions. Buyers will start stock piling for Christmas so trade looks set fair for the near future.

A mixed show of steers sold to a high of 271p/kg and £1750.66 in the lump - plenty of cattle on the lean side here.

Heifer trade absolutely on fire selling to a high of 321p/kg with seven cattle 300 pence a kilo and above. Heavier females topped up nicely to £1848 in the lump.

The bull trade didn't disappoint with best Continentals selling to 258p/kg with others to £1854 as a body. Second string types were an exceptional trade with Black and White bulls in strong demand selling past 200p/kg to 213p/kg.

2 cows met a firm trade as abattoirs attempt to pull value out of the cows. 818kg assured Blonde cross cows sold to 148p/kg or £1210.64 with 690kg Holstein boners to 88p/kg.

A cracking well meated Limousin from Mr Morris topped at 271p/kg at 646kg or £1750.66 in the lump. 644kg Blonde from Dave Chilton sold well to 261p/kg. Blue crosses from Terry Bebb added up well at £1662.27 at 766kg. 598kg Saler steers sold to 236p/kg from Mrs 'B'.

44 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 266P/KG

Evans (Curdale) sold their super run of five to 321p/kg for 528kg with others to 310p/kg, 304p/kg and 297p/kg from the same home. Early riser Andrew Bishop sold his British Blue to 317p/kg and his Limmie to 300p/kg but his handy weight trouble maker sailed to 314p/kg for 438kg. 498kg Lims from the Parkes boys topped their run at 299p/kg with another to 298p/kg. 624kg Black and White sold to 291p/kg or £1815.84 from Evans (Curdale) again but with Glyn Powell selling his tremendous finished Blonde to £1848.96 for 642kg. A fresh buyer for butchers' heifers today.

Peter Kirton's quality Limousin's sold to 258p/kg and 254p/kg for 654kg and 730kg respectively, with Glyn Powell's handy weight 492kg thumping Blonde to 250p/kg. Steve Perkins emptied a yard with his last two selling to 249p/kg with Harold and Rob Pugh selling their best to 244p/kg for 660kg. Black and Whites sold to 213p/kg for 528kg from John Cantrill. Friesian Holsteins, Herefords and all dairy bred types a great trade all through.

The trade holding firm on all sorts, with several pens of half meated ewes forward to average £82. A pen of shapey Beltex ewes from Davies, Frodesley Hall Farm topped the day's trading at £146 with others to £135 from Mr Preen. The Brick household sold their tup to £141 with others to £136 and £134.

Pen after pen of mules with the strongest to £114 from DT Livestock and £105 from TR Brown. Cheviot Mules to £98, with plain enough mules to £80. Cheviots to £103 with smaller ewes to £88. Well meated Romneys to £108. Plenty of continentals crossing the £100 mark, Texels £120 with Suffolks to £113 from Evans, Day House.
