### Prime Cattle Report (Red)

#### 207 PRIME CATTLE

More cattle forward in line with Monday's trend. Quality somewhat lacking with more ordinary shaped cattle forward, some over fat and some requiring more feeding. Our overall market average of 193p/kg truly reflected this and there was a very strong Holstein influence in the bull department.

Only a sprinkling of steers penned this morning, with a few of them better suited to the stores. Best fleshed steers sold to 240p/kg or to £1621.10 in the lump. Another cracking good trade on best heifers saw 267p/kg to pinnacle, with two others 260p/kg and above. Heavy heifers sold to £1491.36.

A mixed bull trade in line with the very mixed entry. Best Continental bulls sold to 225p/kg with cattle under 16 months at an advantage. Black and white bulls sold to 181p/kg. Heavy bulls 28 months of age sold to £1453.02.

#### 27 COWS & 4 STOCK BULLS SOLD TO AV. 96P/KG

There is little demand for cow beef at the moment and with plenty of cows available nationally, trade is pretty grim.

Best meated Friesian cows 36 months sold to 147p/kg for 740kg. Hereford cows sold to 129p/kg for 626kg. Devon & Stabiliser cows sold to 115p/kg for 668kg and 626kg- these were all fair meat. Steaking cows sold from 87p/kg – 104p/kg and looked very cheap. Plain cows showed less depreciation selling between 61p/kg and 80p/kg. Stock bulls met a difficult trade with shapey Limousins to 105p/kg for 978kg and 1074kg pure Herefords to 100p/kg.

#### 131 CLEAN CATTLE

19 steers sold to average 202p/kg. A super run of fed Continentals from Gerald Kincaid sold to 240p/kg for 656kg, with another Limousin to 234p/kg for 620kg. His 754kg Charolais sold to 215p/kg to add up to £1621.10. 42 month Simmentals sold to 172p/kg from Phil Clarke.

112 heifers sold to average 210p/kg. Another good show from Richard Parkes stole the show with three heifers on or above 260p/kg up to 267p/kg for 502kg British Blue. Handy 442kg Limousins sold to 258p/kg from Kytes Nest. 534kg Limousins sold to 254p/kg from Alastair Beedles. Shadymoor Herefords to 224p/kg from Dave Chilton. Free martens to 170p/kg from Dave Johnson.

Two Limmies, both weighing 628kg, achieved 218p/kg and 217p/kg for Richard Morris. 564kg Lims from Paul Taylor sold to 217p/kg also. Rob Morris' Blues and Lims sold to 216p/kg for 616kg and 598kg.

Mary Beaumont sold Friesians to 181p/kg for 578kg and another to 178p/kg for 554kg. There were several very lean and/or old bulls forward today.
