WEEKLY REPORT – 12.11.19



150 PRIME CATTLE

A handful more clean cattle forward but with a much more varied entry. More native breed heifers and steers penned this morning with a few more over thirty months sprinkled in. A consistent trade throughout with a sharp trade on butchers cattle once again with handier weights harder to find.

More steers in town saw trade a little better without being 'on fire'! Best shaped bullocks sold to 204p/kg, with heavy bullocks to £1420 in the lump.

Heifers sold passed or to 250p/kg on three occasions to a high of 254p/kg. Heavy females sold to £1344.

Very few sucklers in the bull section with most best bulls pretty heavy. Continentals sold to 189p/kg with Herefords to 178p/kg. Heavy bulls sold pretty well to £1592 at 18 months. Black and White bulls sold to 165p/kg and £1124 in the lump.

1 COW, 2 STEERS AND 1 STOCK BULL

Limousin cross cows lacking shape but with some meat sold to 100p/kg for 612kg.

Blonde stock bull sold well to 136p/kg for 994kg (£1351.84).

97 CLEAN CATTLE

18 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 160P/KG

580kg Blondes from Frank Millichamp headed this department at 204p/kg closely followed by Limousins from 'Mrs B' selling 638kg to 201p/kg. Other Limmies sold to 191p/kg from Alastair Beedles at 616kg. Heavy Limmies sold to 185p/kg for 768kg again from 'Mrs B' (£1420.80). Hereford x steers to 169p/kg from Phillip Terry.

79 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 190P/KG

The averages belie a fair trade but with more second quality beasts evident.

Richard Parkes' useful run sold to 254p/kg and 251p/kg around that half ton mark with 524kg Limmies from Roger Jordin selling to 250p/kg and 542kg to 248p/kg from Matt Bower (£1344.16).

53 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 154P/KG

A poor sample in this section saw Richard and Ben Price taking the headlines at 189p/kg for 626kg Limousins, with their 870kg 18 month bull to 183p/kg (£1592.10). Hereford crosses sold to 178p/kg at 578kg from John Brodie and Family with Blue Friesians to 177p/kg from Ed Green.

Black and Whites sold to 165p/kg from Andrew Maiden with David Preece's Holstein to £1122 in the lump.

A similar entry to last week although quality lambs few and far between. Those best lambs on offer sold to 234p/kg at 44kg from LR Morgan & Son (£103) and 50kg from the same field to 219p/kg (£109.50).

Only 150 lambs under 40kg to 209p/kg from Dave Green. Generally lighter lambs selling extremely well with very commercial 35kg to 38kg around 195p/kg.

Currently Bridgnorth is experiencing high demand for quality lambs with both butchers and wholesalers looking for shaply finished sheep. Heavier lambs averaged £90 per head the best breaking the £100 barrier to £109.50 and commercial 54kg Charollais at £94.50.
