It was nice to see a few more cattle forward but not too surprising following last week’s flier! We did not quite reach the heady heights of last Tuesday, but still saw 14 cattle over £2000 to a top of £2350 for steers. More handy-weight butcher’s types penned today which met great returns.

A nice run of steers saw a high of 337p/kg or £2351 in the lump.

Some great heifers forward sold to a top of 384p/kg with heavier females to £2233.

Disappointing bull entries with all buyers in action, with the best to 309p/kg or £2008 as a whole.

14 STEERS SOLD TO OV AV 312P/KG

A great run of read Limmies from Mrs B shone here with her heaviest selling to 333p/kg for 706kg (£2350.98), with 648kg making top pence per kilo at 337p/kg or £2183.76. Roger Jordin’s 578kg steer sold to 310p/kg, with John Cantrill getting to the back of the shed selling to 307p/kg for 540kg.

48 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV AV 314P/KG

Handyweight Charolais were the order of the day from the Parkes family, market topping at 384p/kg for 490kg. Lims from Andrew Dalton took second spot at 376p/kg for 516kg, with Evans Curdale’s best to 374p/kg for 554kg and Roger Jordin selling 478kg to 370p/kg. Mrs B was mentioned here also with her 638kg Limmie at 350p/kg or £2233.

Mr Powell cleared up his Saler bulls having outshone and outrun the competition making 309p/kg for 650kg. Stabilisers from Dan Watkins sold to 306p/kg for 640kg. Archie Meddins sold his Simmentals to 294p/kg for 660kg.
