167 PRIME CATTLE

As buyers get filled up with product following the long Christmas break, trade has eased a little with all cattle averaging 186p/kg including a large number of Holstein bulls and non-FABBL over-age cattle. Well finished cattle with shape still found plenty of customers to a high of 241p/kg.

More steers forward met a satisfactory trade with many on the lean side for most tastes. Steers sold to 230p/kg or just short of £1500 in the lump.

Handy-weight best butchers heifers were not as plentiful in number and sold to 241p/kg on two occasions for cattle around half a tonne. More commercial sorts saw trade back 5-10p/kg generally.

Again, a very mixed sample of bulls with black and white numbers very good. Trade here stuck it will with best suckler bred cattle to 228p/kg and 226p/kg. Well-finished Holsteins were eagerly bid at to 191p/kg.

29 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL SOLD TO AV. 89P/KG

Cow trade a little easier following some Monday markets being flooded with dairy cows. Obviously the milk price will encourage underproductive cows into the cull market more quickly than they might normally show.

Fit Blonde cows sold to 164p/kg from Roy Kinnish, with Mike Davies selling to 134p/kg for his Limmie Blue. Holstein cows with meat and not too much middle sold to 113p/kg from Trevor Dale.

884kg Limousin stock bulls sold to 118p/kg from Todd Harris.

118 CLEAN CATTLE

46 steers sold to av. 188p/kg – Ray & Marianne Bason took the headlines her with their 450kg Limmie selling to 230p/kg, with heavy steers from Simon Jones to 226p/kg for 648kg and 215p/kg for 644kg both British Blues. Blues from John Cantrill also sold to 215p/kg, with Chris & Gordon Jones' Limousins closely following at 213p/kg. John Cantrill's Herefords topped at 170p/kg. Sam Jones' Holstein sold to 165p/kg.

72 Heifers sold to average 196p/kg — Dave Chilton & Tony Barker shared top spot today at 241p/kg for 480kg and 500kg respectively. Third place was occupied by Roy Kinnish's 538kg Blonde at 238p/kg. The Chilton stable were the only other beast over 230p/kg at 235p/kg for 470kg. Heavy Blondes to £1507 from Martin Osbourne.


