#### **194 PRIME CATTLE**

There were a few more clean cattle and a few more bulls forward this morning. Cattle that suited most ideal specifications for the buyers saw an improved trade, whereby heavy or beasts too fat or ultra-lean met similar returns to last week. Our overall average of 171p/kg included some storey sorts and some young cows with swinging udders!

A good number of steers forward were perhaps not quite the sample of last Tuesday and saw a slightly sharper trade selling passed 200p/kg on two occasions and to £1290 in the lump. There were some saleable butchers heifers presented today and these sold to a high of 240p/kg.

The bull sample was mixed with best sucklers selling close to 200p/kg if not too big. Good meat Friesian Holsteins sold up to 163p/kg with few bulls selling below 130p/kg.

#### **13 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL SOLD TO AV. 113P/KG**

A very good cow trade with too few entered for awaiting orders. It has been noted that some local cows have been escaping our net to larger cow centres but having used extra diesel, lost extra weight, been charged more commission and wasted the best part of a day - are they actually better off? They have got to make a lot more to justify avoiding their local facility where their stock can arrive within an hour and be weighed and sold shortly afterwards - is the grass really greener?

866kg Charolais cows sold to 137p/kg with 630kg Limousins to 129p/kg. There were no best quality Holsteins forward but steakers sold with belly made 102p/kg for 756kg. Simmental stock bulls sold to 114p/kg for 952kg.

#### **126 CLEAN CATTLE**

47 steers sold to average 171p/kg. Ed Roberts' handy 456kg Limousin sold to 202p/kg to head their section, with 536kg Limousins from Ray Bason selling to 201p/kg. 592kg Blonde crosses sold to 190p/kg from Frank Millichamp. 698kg Blondes from Martin Mottershead lumped up to £1291.30. Shapeless Herefords sold to 144p/kg with Shorthorns to 150p/kg.

79 heifers sold to average 188p/kg. Steve Perkins' run of 5 was headed by his 480kg British Blue realising 240p/kg with his Limmie to 231p/kg. 498kg Limousins from Richard Parkes sold to 226p/kg for 506kg, with 512kg to the same from Roger Jordin.

#### **68 YOUNG BULLS OV. AV. 155P/KG**

32 Holsteins, Friesians, Shorthorns etc. were forward along with many above 16 months of age. Vendors with tidy suckler bulls are definitely not getting enough for their goods wherever they may sell them at present but believe it or not,

many of our bulls were dearer than the reduced deadweight quotations available this week.

574kg Blondes from Andrew Craig took the headlines at 196p/kg, with 596kg to 190p/kg from Stuart Bebb. Shapely heavies sold to 190p/kg for 670kg.

Friesians sold reasonably well with Mary Beaumont and David Evans both achieving 163p/kg.
