91 PRIME CATTLE

A few less numbers forward on a very hot Tuesday morning saw trade no faster, as expected, as wholesalers and butchers find price resistance, especially on roasting joints. Best butchers' cattle held up pretty well, but this was helped by some absolute stunning cattle penned this morning. One well known buyer commented he thought they were the best cattle he ever bought! 17 cattle sold on or above 300p/kg.

Only a handful of steers sold to a very respectable 320p/kg with heavy steers to £2015 in the lump.

Heifers sold to a high of 346p/kg with two others in the 340p/kg and a top price per head of £2009.

There were some tidy bulls forward selling to a top of 288p/kg. No bulls over £2000 this morning with Holsteins almost non-existent.

Four cows sold to a high of 170p/kg for a leanish Limmie at 632kg. A fair go on Jersey cows selling to 134p/kg.

Not all the best types today saw 570kg Limousins from Marcus Whitehouse star at 320p/kg. Overweight 826kg Angus crosses sold to a lump of £2015.44 from Keith Alderson. Black & white Herefords from Mrs B Sold to 259p/kg for 558kg.

52 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 286P/KG

A good run of five from Evans Curdale stole the limelight with their 548kg Limmie at 346p/kg, with their 528kg model to 342p/kg. Mrs B took third and fourth spot with her Charolais crosses at 340p/kg and 337p/kg respectively, with Neil Perkins and Harvey Parkes selling their best in the 330p/kg bracket. Curdale's heaviest Limmie at 620kg stacked up well at £2008.80.

31 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 249P/KG

A very useful black Limmie 572kg from Marcus Whitehouse started his day well at 288p/kg, with 648kg homebred Limmie from Charlie Sandells selling a close second at 282p/kg. Two Limmies from Andrew Preece also excelled at 280p/kg for 626kg and 620kg. Holstein to £1762.68 for 794kg from Lee Preece.

Lambs eased towards the end of last week and continued to ease throughout the start of this week, with customers reporting an over-supply of lamb in European markets, a worsening exchange rate and supermarkets keen to dump lamb in Smithfield - all of which do not help trade.

An average of 301p/kg, with trade for better-shaped, finished lambs still brisk, selling to a top of 358p/kg for 42.5kg from Evans Curdale. Tony Davies' first draw topped the sale at £153 for 51kg, with all his lambs £150 or over. Just finished lambs remain hard work and lighter weights unless very fresh - tend to meet a tepid trade.
