Disappointing numbers with the bull section being very quiet. Bull trade is volatile as present and it is difficult to advise when to send – a few each week is probably the best plan. Some excellent heifers forward with no steers at all – possibly a first!

9 heifers sold to 300p/kg and above to a top of 319p/kg. Heavy heifers sold to £1720 in the lump. A very small sample of bulls met a reasonable trade with only ultralean types struggling. Continentals sold to 237p/kg or £1678 in the lump. Black and Whites sold to 193p/kg.

3 cows met a sharp trade, with young fed cows selling to 170p/kg for 862kg. More cows required each week.

Evans (Curdale) stole the limelight once again selling their best 530kg Limmie to 319p/kg, with another to 310p/kg.
