135 PRIME CATTLE

A few less cattle met a slightly easier trade following last week's bonanza. With large deadweight centres dropping their quotations once again, the live trade is still well in front and more cattle were needed with a strong buying contingent around the ring.

Only a small compliment of steers with no top notchers forward and sold to 207p/kg with heavy dairy bred cattle to £1319.50 in the lump.

Butchers heifers were in more plentiful supply with the best selling to 261p/kg, with heavier heifers to £1463.70.

The quality of our bull entry was much improved but there were fewer forward. Handy shop bulls sold to 217p/kg with heavy bulls over 16 months to £1350. Meated Friesians saw firm demand selling to 168p/kg on two occasions.

ONLY 8 COWS

Only 8 cows sold to a high of 158p/kg for 694kg Limousin (£1096.52), with rich Hereford cows to 116p/kg for 756kg. 688kg Friesians with reasonable flesh sold to 106p/kg. Boning cows a little easier, down to 57p/kg. Non-assured cows at 10p/kg disadvantage.

87 CLEAN CATTLE

10 steers sold to av. 174p/kg – Kevin & Nigel Truswell's 570kg Limousin cross sold to 207p/kg to head this section, with other Limmies to 201p/kg for 588kg from Joanne Haycocks. Holsteins to 158p/kg for 620kg again from the Truswells.

77 heifers sold to av. 215p/kg — A superb run of eleven from Richard Parkes was headed by his Charolais at 261p/kg for 478kg, to average 246p/kg all through. 574kg Limmie Blues from Mr Thomas sold to 255p/kg (£1464) visiting us for the first time. 488kg Limmies sold to 254p/kg from Kevin Scott. Handy weight 442kg sold to 245p/kg for a very deserving cause. Second quality and/or heavier heifers met a very good trade.

48 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 174P/KG


