116 PRIME CATTLE

Cattle numbers veer from being short to very tight. A cracking good trade throughout especially on well-finished cattle. All heifers sold to average 217p/kg. Several very poor bulls would help reduce averages boosted by the better sorts. Many more cattle are needed as butchers and wholesalers ready themselves for the festive period.

A small sample of steers saw Continentals to 224p/kg with leaner, heavier bullocks to £1335.

Butchers heifers sailed to 254p/kg, with ten others 240p/kg and above. Heavier females to £1316.

Heavy Continental bulls sold to 218p/kg, with good bulls in very short supply generally. Good Holstein numbers sold from 50p/kg to 169p/kg!

5 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL

A small sample once again with trade very steady. British Blue cows sold on two occasions to 109p/kg, with Limousin stock bulls to 105p/kg for 992kg.

66 CLEAN CATTLE

12 Steers sold to ov.av. 184p/kg – Handy-weight Limousins topped at 224p/kg for 568kg from Phil Roberts who also sold to 217p/kg. Mark Jones started off the sale with his 568kg Blonde at 228p/kg, with John & Tom Hill selling red Herefords to 213p/kg for 534kg. Mr & Mrs Vogel sold their 664kg Charolais cross to £1334.64.

54 Heifers sold to ov.av. 217p/kg – 504kg Lims from Matt & Wendy Bower soared to 254p/kg, closely followed by Richard Parkes selling three to 249p/kg to average 242p/kg on seven Continentals.

Roger Jordin also sold to 249p/kg for 516kg, with David Chilton and Richard Povall achieving 247p/kg for the start of their respective runs. 572kg Limousins to £1315.60 from Same Jones.

50 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 168P/KG

672kg Limousins from the Morris, Stud Farm, took top spot at 218p/kg, with IGC Morris' 656kg selling to 215p/kg. Mark Jones sold Blondes to 214p/kg, with Glyn Powell selling others to 212p/kg.

Holsteins sold to 169p/kg for Stuart Bebb and Colin Evans, with Mr Evans adding up to £1043.20.
