131 PRIME CATTLE

A more mixed bunch forward this morning following the Primestock Show last week. Best cattle sold above expectation with most butchers having already filled Christmas stocks. This bodes well for next week's Tuesday market with buyers looking to get New Year beef in the fridges prior to the holiday period. Lowe steer numbers saw steers selling to 220p/kg with heavies not the very best to £1292.

Quality butchers heifers sold to just below 250p/kg on two occasions for beasts below half a tonne. Heavy heifers, over thirty months, sold to £1371.

Bull trade was sharp with seemingly fewer numbers about in most markets. Continentals sold to 215p/kg without there being any best suckler bulls forward. The black and white trade was a revelation yet again with well-finished Holsteins to 185p/kg.

ONLY 6 COWS FORWARD although there were several slips forward in the clean section. A much dearer trade with Saler cows to 149p/kg for 706kg. Buyers will be looking for cows next week so please send if you have cows or stock bulls ready.

80 CLEAN CATTLE

Only steers sold to average 182p/kg — Handy-weight 538kg Herefords from Roger Rowson took the headlines selling to 220p/kg (Roger wasn't too happy when his so-called mates told him it may have won a prize last week!). Bazadaise from Martin Faulconbridge sold to 214p/kg with Limousins to 202p/kg for 610kg from Mrs B. Dave Chilton's "Holstein x" sold to £1292.04. 70 heifers sold to av. 203p/kg — Richard Parkes' Limousin and Jan Edwards' Bazadaise took the top slots at 249p/kg both 486kg, with the Jordin stable selling 512kg to 242p/kg. Over-age Devon heifers to £1371.14for 766kg from Bob Beaman.

51 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 176P/KG

602kg Limousin crosses from Colin Evans sold to 215p/kg with 636kg British Blues to 208p/kg from Ted Jackson. Bazadaise 540kg sold to 207p/kg from Martin Faulconbridge.


Holsteins sold to 185p/kg and 183p/kg from Richard Hartley, with Richards Hotchkiss selling to 180p/kg.

Trade nationally easier towards the end of last week and this trend is continuing this week.

Quality paid hand over fist with a superb run of Beltex lambs from Peter Morris 208p/kg to 220p/kg however, top honours this week to Ed Bunning 236p/kg for 38.5kg. Not far behind were Rob Morris' Texels over 200p/kg to 207p/kg for 44.5kg and £92.20 per head.

Generally trade harder work with customers for lambs up to 43kg willing to bid up, but heavier lambs hard work although still comparing well against dead-weight and other auctions. Only the best pens realising over £80 with most sheep trading around £85.
