138 PRIME CATTLE

Numbers remain tight with more cattle needed to satisfy the requirements of our regular buyers. There were some well-meated cattle forward but with the heifers generally a little heavier than recent weeks. Breaking cattle and plainer sorts in strong demand with best butchers cattle 2p/kg less money generally.

Small bullock numbers with very few best steers sold to 210p/kg or £1260 in the limp. Several Holsteins and over-age cattle about and plenty of demand for these.

Retail heifers met a firm trade but without the real bite of recent weeks and sold to 245p/kg.

Bull trade very good with lots of bidders for all shapes and types of bull. No absolute aces penned this morning with dairy bulls selling to 218p/kg for 552kg British Blue crosses. Friesian Holsteins a tremendous go to 177p/kg.

14 COWS MET A FLYING TRADE TO AV. 124P/KG

It really paid to stay "local" once again with cows "on fire" selling to 169p/kg for British Blues from Gordon Jones, with Blondes to 148p/kg for 640kg from Brian Watkins. Fit Jerseys from Arley Farming sailed to 102p/kg.

83 CLEAN CATTLE

Only 12 steers sold to average 168p/kg – Blondes and Blues from Mrs B topped this department at 210p/kg and 202p/kg respectively, with British Blues to 189p/kg from Sam Jones. 702kg Limousins 34m from Phil Clarke sold to 177p/kg. Friesian Holsteins to 159p/kg from Richard Ince.

71 heifers sold to av. 200p/kg – 470kg Limousins from Steve Perkins sold to 245p/kg, with Richard Parkes taking silver medal spot at 244p/kg with his 498kg British Blue. 504kg Blondes from the Watkins stable sold to 237p/kg, with Roger Jordin and Neil Perkins both achieving 236p/kg. Mrs Burgoyne's hefty British Blue sold to £1451.88 for 666kg, with Nigel Fieldhouse's Limousins to £1423.80.

55 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 173P/KG

Reared calved from Stuart Bebb sold to 218p/kg and 212p/kg both British Blues, with another Limousin to 214p/kg. Blondes from Brian Watkins 564kg sold to 217p/kg. Other Blues to 205p/kg from John Gore, with Bill Yeoman's Blondes to 204p/kg for 528kg. Peter Gore topped the black and white trade at 177p/kg, with Harold Pugh selling to 168p/kg and 167p/kg.
