PRIME CATTLE (RED)

180 PRIME CATTLE

A much improved number forward following the short post-Easter week last sale. Trade was very mixed with butchers and wholesalers all reporting slow demand and with the large supermarket suppliers taking money out once again yesterday morning. Best cattle, especially handier weight sorts met a dearer trade than our last two sales but with plenty of heavier out of specification sorts much more difficult to sell.

More steers forward saw the best handier weights to 208p/kg with heavier types selling to £1370 in the lump.

Butchers heifers were more plentiful and met a very satisfactory end selling to 249p/kg or £1289.60 as a whole.

Heavier breaking clean cattle sold to a slower trade about 2-6p/kg down on last week.

Bull trade a little easier also but well-finished cattle whether Continentals or Holsteins sold well on the trade, Best sucklers sold to 209p/kg for 624kg, with British Friesians to 180p/kg.

ONLY 6 COWS SOLD TO AV. 113P/KG

A very disappointing show met a good trade with buyers for 50 plus cows awaiting. 800kg Charolais sold to 143p/kg from Mrs Vale, with Bill Rodenhurst selling Holsteins to 114p/kg for 702kg.

120 CLEAN CATTLE

41 steers sold to average 174p/kg – 546kg British Blues from Charlie Sandells topped this section at 208p/kg, closely tracked by Dave Chilton's Limousin 542kg at 207p/kg. 500kg Lims hit 200p/kg from Marianne & Ray Bason. 688kg Blondes from Shropshire & Jones added up well to £1369.12 (199p/kg). 692kg black and white steers sold to 158p/kg from John Rogers.

79 heifers sold to average 199p/kg – A cracking run from Roger Jordin sold to 249p/kg and 246p/kg for Lims around 500kg. Richard Parkes and Matt Bower both sold Lims to 238p/kg, with Richard & Stuart Bebb selling to 237p/kg. Breaking cattle were approximately 5p/kg less money, with fat harder to sell than lean.

60 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 172P/KG

A decent entry of bulls also found trade a little steadier but more than in line with the competition.

Two British Blues from Ed Green sold to 209p/kg and 200p/kg for 624kg and 608kg, with 552kg Blondes to 201p/kg from Brian Watkins. Richard Povall sold Lims to 200p/kg for 554kg. 492kg Blondes from Bill Yeomans just missed the magic figure at 198p/kg.

British Friesians from Henry Yates sold to 180p/kg and another

to 168p/kg, with Charlie Lloyd's Friesian to 167p/kg.

Even with heavier hoggs harder work, plenty still over £100 per head to £118.50 for 74.5kg Suffolks.

An overall average of £100.75 and an all-time record breaking top price of £187.

The previous all-time top price of £164 was surpassed for the second pen sold of 3 Texel rams from Dave Halford at £167 only to be outdone by 3 other rams later in the sale at £187 from Robert Lilley.

Ewes sold to £134 for Suffolks x 3 and Continental cross ewes to £129. The biggest increase in value of North Country Mules selling to £116 with one consignment of Mules averaging £115.40.

Swales ewes sold to £95, Cheviot £101 and small Welsh £54. A single goat realised £70.

21 rams averaged £120 with only one under £100 to £187.
