138 PRIME CATTLE

Again a fantastic show of clean cattle but very short of bulls and cows. There is some bite in the trade at the moment, with good demand at the retail end generally but numbers of available prime cattle are tight. Great credit to our producers once again who put some quality goods in front of a full ring of buyers.

A small handful of steers saw similar returns with best types to 216p/kg or £1448 in the lump.

Many shapey butchers' heifers forward sold to 259p/kg or £1337 in the lump. Plenty of orders for the best and for more commercial sorts and more could have sold without affecting returns.

Less bulls forward as numbers appear to dry up despite trade firming. Twice as many are required with fresh orders operating at the moment. Continental bulls sold to 225p/kg and Black and Whites selling to 178p/kg.

Only 3 cows sold to a flying trade selling to 157p/kg for Limousin crosses at 648kg and less shapey cows to 126p/kg + 125p/kg.

Limousin crosses from Paul Taylor headed the bullock trade at 210p/kg for 614kg Limousin. Ted Rogers' much-meated Limousin sold to 211p/kg, with Marcus Whitehouse selling 608kg to 205p/kg. Dave Bradley's heavy homebred Limousin sold to £1447.86 for 818kg.

91 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 215P/KG

Roger Jordin was top dog selling 482kg Limmies to 259p/kg. Evans (Curdale Farm) took silver medal at 254p/kg for 526kg, with Mrs 'B' in third spot at 250p/kg for 506kg. Steve Perkins sold his slick Limmies to 247p/kg, with a great run from Richard Parkes to 246p/kg.

38 BULLS SOLD TO OV.AV 197.2P/KG

A sharp trade saw suckler bulls from Tim Madeley take the top spot at 225p/kg for a 606kg Limmie. 540kg Blondes from Brian and Dan Watkins sold nicely to 223p/kg, with 568kg Limousins from the Rodenhurst' to 219p/kg. Two shapey but lean Blues from Mark Jones sold to 218p/kg. Heavy Blondes 680kg to 214p/kg from Mark Lewis.

Black and White trade getting dearer, selling to 178p/kg from James Woolrich. The leaner they were, the better the trade it seemed.
