Rain this morning and most of the harvest complete encouraging more cattle forward. Trade a little easier with leaner cattle forward in a place or two. As per every week, well finished cattle are the order of the day with more buyers for these.

Some useful steers forward once again sold to a high of 281p/kg with £1,740 top call per head.

Best butchers beasts sold to 292p/kg with two others to 290p/kg. Heavy heifers sold to £1,729.16 in the lump.

Bull trade was sharp once again. Best Continentals sold to 256p/kg with heavies past £1,800 on two occasions. Black and White bulls were generally a little plainer today and sold to 206p/kg.

11 COWS SOLD TO OV.AV. 146P/KG

A nice show of barrens today with 4 buyers in attendance. 648kg fed black Limmies topped at 166p/kg with South Devon cows selling to 159p/kg or £1,335.60 in the lump. Good cow entries needed each week.

55 CLEAN CATTLE

14 STEERS SOLD TO OV.AV. 229P/KG

Shapely Blondes from Conington Farms Ltd topped this section at 281p/kg for 548kg with Evans (Curdale) selling their red Limmies to 271p/kg for 594kg. Roger Jordin's well topped Lims sold to 266p/kg or £1,739.64 in the lump. Steers that were too lean would have been better kept a little longer.

71 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 241P/KG

Richard Parkes was top dog here selling to 292p/kg for 480kg. Two of the best from Evans (Curdale) both achieved 290p/kg just above half a ton. Heavy Limousin heifers from Andrew Bishop sold to £1,729.16 for 622kg with 760kg Blondes to £1,725.20 from Dave Preece. You really can't get your heifers and steers too fit.

81 BULLS SOLD TO OV.AV. 217P/KG

A great entry was headed by Malcolm Davies selling his homebred Limmie to 256p/kg for 612kg. Heavy red Limmies from Roger Jordin at 730kg took second spot at 255p/kg with David Jones' Lims stopping at 249p/kg for 584kg. The Jordin's Limousin stacked up well at £1861.50 with distance traveller James, Llandysul selling to £1826.72 at 784kg.


