#### **159 PRIME CATTLE**

A slightly larger complement of cattle forward saw trade no faster. Best quality cattle were easiest sold well above renowned local centres and dead quotations for the week. Our overall market average of 175p/kg included several over thirty month cattle, many of these over 48 months.

Several steers lacked finish today with best sorts selling to 209p/kg or £1338 in the lump. It was a shame a few cattle had just passed their 30m birthday!

Butchers heifers were not quite the standard of last week but still sold to 237p/kg with heavies to £1350 as a whole. Second string cattle helped reduce averages but were not as cheap as they looked.

Bull trade no dearer with some good bulls forward in places if not a little heavy for most requirements. Suckler bulls sold to 199p/kg with heavies passed £1300 on several occasions. Plainer bulls were generally more difficult to sell.

#### 24 COWS SOLD TO AVERAGE 80P/KG

Most cows were plain today hence the above average! Best meat cows sold to 130p/kg on two occasions for 686kg and 790kg Limousins. Holsteins sold to 90p/kg for 758kg with a little finish.

If you have plain cows and surplus feed, our advice is to put the two together and wait until January!

#### **95 CLEAN CATTLE**

Only 20 steers sold to av. 166p/kg – Red and black Limmies from Gerald Kincaid sold from 196p/kg to 209p/kg, with Charolais to 201p/kg from Malcolm Davies who also sold Hereford crosses to 178p/kg. 896kg sold to 146p/kg at 41 months from Clive Edwards. More well-finished steers were needed.

Only 75 Heifers sold to average 193p/kg — Roger Jordin needed the beef section with his 522kg Limousin at 237p/kg. A handy body from Andrew Preece sold to 235p/kg at 365kg with Ray Bason and Neil Perkins also selling above 230p/kg. 652kg Limousin crosses lumped up to £1349.64 from IGC Morris.

#### 64 YOUNG BULLS OV. AV. 160P/KG

There are many bulls being sold before they are fit at the moment. Please leave them at home on a hopper rather than worry about their age — especially if under 620kg or thereabouts.

622kg and 620kg Limousins both achieved 199p/kg from George Evans. 658kg Limousins sold to 194p/kg from James Woolrich. 522kg British Blues sold to 191p/kg from Phil Clarke.
