Good numbers penned this morning as producers look to market cattle prior to the Christmas festivities and making room for lambing. As anticipated, the edge was off the trade this morning with retailers and wholesalers having stock piled their meat stocks over recent weeks in readiness for the holiday rush. No cattle over that magic £3 per kilo, but with 293p/kg top price or £1760 In the lump.

Some decent steers forward but with a few on the lean side harder work. Best quality sold to 260p/kg with heavies to £1708 in the lump.

Butchers heifers sold to 293p/kg for cattle around half a ton, with four others 290p/kg and above. There were some very tidy heavier females forward which topped at £1662 in the lump.

Bull trade probably took the biggest knock in values today, especially the Black and White department. Best Continental bulls sold to a high of 256p/kg with heavy bulls to £1760 in the lump, although heavy bulls were few and far between. Holstein bulls sold to 198p/kg and were 10-15p/kg less than recent sales.

Only two cows today were both small Herefords, selling to 108p/kg for 466kg.

A great run from Dave Roberts stole the honours here selling to 293p/kg, 292p/kg and 290p/kg for butchers weights around 500kg. 496kg Lims from Richard Parkes also sold to 290p/kg with slightly heavier heifers to 286p/kg for 540kg from Evans, Curdale and 572kg to 285p/kg from Richard Fenton who also sold to £1662.44 for 598kg Limousin. Dave Chilton and John Elgin also sold their best above £1600 in the lump.





59 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV 195p/kg

Will and Jackie Forrester's stunning Limousins sold to 251p/kg and 250p/kg for quality around the 700kg mark but were edged out by Rob Morris' best at 256p/kg for 562kg Limousin. A plentiful supply of Black and Whites met a slower trade with Roger Rowson's square Holstein reaching 198p/kg for 558kg.

For the first time in months trade eased with customers suddenly over done with lambs and the wholesale trade cooling off, maybe a cautionary reaction to the change in Covid restrictions and the increasing possibility of lockdown following the festive period.

Together with a very mixed entry of lambs trade was back averaging 260p/kg although quality and finished lambs remain keenly sought after with best Texel lambs to 321p/kg for 42kg from Stuart Moss.

Heavy lambs still averaged £141 to £168 for 60kg lambs from Uncle Nick and several pens of 45kg plus lambs over 300p/kg.

More lighter weights selling to 270p/kg for 34kg Texel x lambs from Howard Link. A larger entry of Welsh lambs 28kg to 32kg traded around 250p/kg to 259p/kg.
