WEEKLY REPORT – 15.01.19



164 PRIME CATTLE

A very good entry but without some of the cream available last week. Bull numbers were very good but very few suckler bulls forward with black and whites the order of the day. Best quality clean cattle at least as dear as our most recent sales, with second quality cattle easily finding customers as long as they had meat and finish. More over thirty month cattle penned this morning.

Steer numbers were fair with best quality above expectations to 225p/kg or £1430. Several Holsteins and leaner sorts helped to reduce averages.

As previously mentioned, best quality in short supply with best suckler heifers sailing to 257p/kg, with several over 240p/kg. Heavy heifers sold to £1411.68.

More bulls with 80% Holstein Friesians. Trade no dearer with best bulls in short supply and this did not help filling orders. Suckler bulls sold to 211p/kg on three occasions, with heavy bulls to £1309. Black and whites saw a steadier trade with some ordinary types amongst them. Best available Friesians sold to 170p/kg.

14 COWS SOLD TO OV. AV. 87P/KG

Cow trade a little better with cow beef seeing more demand at this time. 790kg Limousin crosses from Rob Hartley sold to 124p/kg (£979.60) with his Simmental crosses to 114p/kg. Any producers with cows getting ready for market; be brave and wait a week or two! In any case ring Mark Burgoyne when they have got to go.

96 CLEAN CATTLE

22 Steers sold to ov.av.176p/kg – A super run of well-fed steers from John Cantrill sold to 225p/kg and 222p/kg for 596kg and 602kg respectively, with 620kg and 656kg Blondes from Frank Millichamp both achieving 220p/kg. 588kg Lims from Pete & Simon Raybould sold to 202p/kg. Welsh Blondes and Herefords to 190p/kg and 187p/kg from Mrs B. 600kg Angus to 197p/kg from Bill Yeomans.

74 Heifers sold to ov.av. 205p/kg – Quality from Richard Parkes stole the headlines at 257p/kg, 256p/kg and 255p/kg for heifers 500-530kg. Dave Chilton was just off the podium at 251p/kg for 514kg Limousins, with Roger Jordin and Tony Rochelle selling to 249p/kg. Andrew Craig deserves a mention also at 247p/kg for 528kg. Tony Rochelle's heaviest Limousin added up nicely to £1411.68 for 692kg.

68 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 161P/KG

Two Limousins from IGC Morris at 516kg and 586kg were top dog at 211p/kg, as was Charlie Lloyd with his 548kg Blonde. 602kg Charolais from Roger Tomley sold to 209p/kg, with 658kg Saler crosses to 192p/kg from Howard Mold.

Black and whites as far as the eye could see sold to 170p/kg from James Woolrich, John Davies and Charlie Lloyd.

Light lambs sought after with some very ordinary 30kg to 38kg realising around 200p/kg to 219p/kg from Max Preece & Co.

Top price of the day for almost the last pen sold 42kg from Richard Morgan 228p/kg, although the heavier hoggs proved hard work with plenty realising over £90 to £103.40 for 61.5kg again from Richard Morgan.
