Some very good cattle forward this morning as well as some more commercial sorts – a mixed bag. Trade reflected this with the quality end selling to vendors' expectations, with fatty, natural sorts or cattle that were too lean for most tastes "facing the music".

A great entry of tidy steers sold to 300p/kg or £1836 in the lump, with several near the £1800 mark.

Butcher's heifers were not absolutely "on fire" but sold to a satisfactory 300p/kg with several others 290p/kg plus or £1710 in the lump.

Bull trade was sharp with some useful suckler sorts forward selling to a high of 261p/kg and heavier sorts to £1858 in the lump. Black and Whites were in strong demand and, without any real square sorts, sold to 213p/kg.

Three over thirty-months saw young Blue cows selling to 174p/kg or £1162, with Herefords to 135p/kg. Hereford stock bulls (non-assured) sold to 115p/kg or £1225.90 as a body.

13 STEERS SOLD TO AVERAGE 246P/KG

Andrew Bishop owned the star bullock in amongst strong competition, selling his Limmie to 300p/kg for 612kg (£1836), 610kg from Evans Curdale were inlucky in second spot at 292p/kg with others to 276p/kg for Blondes at £1816.

40 HEIFERS SOLD TO AVERAGE 233P/KG

Evans Curdale got their own back here selling their 542kg Limmie to 300p/kg, with the Dalton stable and 'Mrs B' both selling their best to 296p/kg. Two shapey sorts from Andrew Bishop levelled at 292p/kg, with 'Mrs B' mentioned again at 290p/kg. Heavy heifers sold to £1710.72 for 648kg from James Davies.

56 BULLS SOLD TO AVERAGE 213P/KG

Two cracking Limousins, as usual, from Jackie and Will Forrester, were top dogs here at 261p/kg and 256p/kg or £1832.96 for the heaviest of the two. The Thomas' were distance travellers and sold their heavy Saler to £1857.60 for 860kg. Dan Watkins achieved 254p/kg for his best at 596kg. Black and Whites sold well to 213p/kg from James Woolrich.

Trade easing nationally with heavy weight hoggs suddenly very hard to sell. Ordinary hoggs over 52kg considerably easier than recent weeks.

Lighter, leaner sorts up to 44kg remain in demand with better shaped sheep over 300p/kg to 309p/kg for 40kg Beltex from Pete Morris.

Hoggs under 36kg regardless of quality attracting spirited bidding with 35kg Texel to 283p/kg from Gordon Bennett. More Welsh hoggs over 250p/kg apart from hoggs 25kg to 27kg which are difficult due to the high kill charges per kilo.

Heavy hoggs to £160 from TR Craig & Son and 54kg to 254p/kg from Nigel Kinsey.

Despite the hogg trade realigning, the ewe trade seems to be holding firm with large heavy ewes trading up to £176 for Texel crosses. Small but very shapey Beltex at £150, Suffolk x Mules £135 and North Country Mules £110 to £118 from Josh Munday for well-bred meated ewes.
