117 PRIME CATTLE

Similar numbers forward today, with a great entry of butchers' cattle but with a few less sorts to deplete averages. Trade no faster in reality but definitely no less when deadweight values are accounted for.

The steer entry was generally speaking tidy but averages included 50 month old Dexter's! Charolais crosses sold to 270p/kg with heavier Blondes to £1,913.60 in the lump.

8 heifers 300p/kg and more to a high of 318p/kg. Heavy females sold to just short of £1,800.

Bull trade no faster but with the fitter bulls easiest sold. Lean Holstein/Dairy types looking for a customer at times. Heavy sucklers sold to 233p/kg with heavy, lean sorts past £1,800 in the lump. Best Black and Whites in the 190 pence's today.

3 cows forward sold to a level trade but really required further bag!

85 CLEAN CATTLE

16 STEERS SOLD TO AVERAGE 225P/KG

Super shaped and finished Charolais crosses from James Davies topped here at 270p/kg for 648kg with Limousins from the Dalton stable selling to 264p/kg for 700kg and 680kg (£1,848 and £1,796). Blondes from distance travellers, the Dales, sold to £1,913.60 for 736kg. More well finished steers could have easily sold to advantage today.

69 HEIFERS SOLD TO AVERAGE 253P/KG

A great run of butchers' heifers from Andrew Bishop, Richard Parkes and Evans (Curdale) stole most plaudits, with Mr Bishop selling his best to 318p/kg and 316p/kg. Parkesy sold to 314p/kg with the Curdale crew selling to 300p/kg. There were many punters achieving 290 pence plus, including 'Mrs B' who sold her 616kg Limmie to £1,786.40.

32 BULLS SOLD TO AVERAGE 201P/KG

Glyn Powell's homebred Blondes sold nicely to 233p/kg for 724kg with Mr Jarvis in town selling his 722kg Charolais to 231p/kg. Shapey but super lean Blondes from the Dale's sold to £1,809 for 804kg.

Black and Whites sold to 198p/kg from Roger Rowson at 584kg with his second to 192p/kg.

Another large entry of hogsgs with a variety of breeds and weights represented.

An average this week of 268p/kg, a little firmer than last week with trade firming especially for the very heavy hoggs which at times over the past few weeks have been very hard work.

Best hoggs well over 300p/kg to 336p/kg twice for 43kg and 42kg Beltex hoggs from John Cantrill and Cowley Knoll Farm. Richard Morgan's heavier 46.5kg hoggs at 333p/kg with customers willing to pay for quality. Handier weights keenly sought after with 36kg from Rob Rose to 284p/kg and pen after pen 275p/kg to 280p/kg.

50kg plus hoggs averaged £126 to £135 for 54kg from Ian Morris, although hoggs weighing 46kg to 48kg added up to £154.90 from Richard Morgan.
