133 PRIME CATTLE

Good numbers of clean cattle forward saw trade holding its own, with buyers looking for well finished cattle whatever their weight. Bull trade could have been a lot worse, with some boning plants struggling with covid cases amongst their staff and unable to purchase at all today. Hopefully, things will revert to normality next week but please book your cattle in with Mark Burgoyne prior to the sale day.

Quality not quantity in the steer section saw the cream selling to 266p/kg or £1548 in the lump with no heavy steers penned.

Heifers met a level trade topping at 281p/kg with heavies to £1494.50 in the lump. Plenty of heifers below 500kg forward today.

Half as many bulls forward saw trade a little slower selling to 234p/kg for Continentals with Black and Whites to 182p/kg. Heavies to £1541.28.

13 STEERS SOLD TO OV.AV. 217P/KG

A sprinkling of superstars here saw the Layton's selling a very shapey Hereford cross to 266p/kg for 572kg. Mrs 'B' took second spot with her 600kg Blonde selling to 258p/kg (£1548). The Layton's also sold a British Blue to 252p/kg for 584kg. Handy 556kg Limmies from 'the deservring cause' once again sold to 246p/kg.

83 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 228P/KG

4 cracking Limmies from Andrew Bishop topped at 281p/kg with another to 271p/kg for 484kg + 496kg respectively. Matt and Wendy Bower sold their two best Blues to 270p/kg, with 462kg Lims to the same from Richard Parkes. Mark Jones and Rob Hartley both sold to 260p/kg. 610kg Limmies from Rob Watkins sold to £1494.50 with Ted Rogers selling his 658kg to £1480.50.

37 BULLS SOLD TO OV.AV. 205P/KG

The Layton stable stole the honours here also selling to 234p/kg for a 602kg Limousin. 586kg Blondes from Mark Jones sold to 229p/kg with his heavier Blonde to 228p/kg (£1541.28).

For the first time in many months lambs slipped under £3/kg, with leaner lambs harder work. Weight still pays, with customers once again looking to buy heavier finished lambs.

Pete Kirton’s Texels took top spot 40.5kg Texels at 333p/kg and Burwarton farms 50.0kg’s at £160.50. Ordinary plainer lambs 35kg to 39kg proving hard going with customers driven by price and quality.

Lambs under 34.0kg to 316p/kg for Texels from Haydon Burton with 30kg to 34kg a lot easier to buy than recent sales.

Despite the easier trade the average would still be 70p/kg almost £30 a lamb up on the corresponding week last year.
