Extremely short of cattle as was the case elsewhere. A blistering trade throughout with supply and demand dictating terms. Prices at least 5-10p/kg up on recent sales across the board. Many more beasts were needed to satisfy regular orders or perhaps half fill them!

Some good bullocks today but some weight up in places selling to 229p/kg, with over-weights selling to nearly £1600. An excellent trade on dairy bred sorts with meat.

Best heifers in shorter supply and met an exceptional market to 252p/kg with others just above 530kg to £1325. Commercial clean cattle dealer whatever they were.

Although bull numbers seemed more in line with recent sales trade saw considerable improvement with buyers seeing clean cattle short. Fewer best Continentals sold to 220p/kg or £1323 as a whole. Holstein Friesian bulls an absolute flier to 195p/kg and many over 180p/kg.

5 COWS saw plenty of demand with Farm Assurance essential here. 704kg Blonde cows sold to 164p/kg with smaller Charolais to 144p/kg. Plain Swedish Reds to 108p/kg.

67 CLEAN CATTLE

15 Steers sold to ov.av. 205p/kg – Matt & Wendy Bower emptied their yards to achieve 220p/kg - 229p/kg for four Limousins up to 692kg (£1522.40), with Dave Bradley's 846kg Limmie to £1565.10 in the lump. Hereford crosses sold to 213p/kg for 504kg from Mr England.

52 Heifers sold to ov.av. 214p/kg – Handy-weight quality Limousins from Wallace & Brian Jones sold to steal the headlines at 252p/kg. Roger Jordin sold five Limousins from 241p/kg up to 249p/kg, with Richard Parkes and Andrew Craig selling to 248p/kg.

A very smart run of Texel lambs from Stuart Moss sold to 230p/kg for 41kg and 44kg at £95.90, although 50kg lambs from Peter Levi at £105 topped the sale.

Generally quality lambs well over 200p/kg and commercial finished lambs 195p/kg.
