136 PRIME CATTLE

A few more cattle forward, with quality more mixed this week and looking a little like a 'back end' market. Trade was firm on well fleshed cattle, with best sorts as dear as last week's flier. Once again, there was a large contingent of Holsteins and overagers forward and these are included in our overall average of 190p/kg.

More steers forward which helped filling orders and these sold to 239p/kg and a top price per head of £1403.60 with few heavy steers penned.

Butchers heifers met a very sharp trade selling to 256p/kg, with two others at 250p/kg and plenty at 230p/kg plus. More commercial sorts also held values easily with Holstein heifers selling above £1200 over thirty months and with some 'bag'.

Bull trade held firm with more ordinary Holsteins today. Best bulls sold to 215p/kg with heavy sucklers over £1500. It is noticeable that several producers are bringing bulls over 16 months to us but we are not seeing their cattle that tick all the boxes! Some of these older bulls have managed to get in the top prices this week despite the big players discounting them by 75-100p/kg deadweight. Whilst we are happy to sell these bulls and will always try and make a job of them, can this really be helping the job in the long term? Meated black & white bulls were wanted with Friesians selling to 180p/kg.

9 COWS FORWARD

9 Cows sold to a top price per head of £936.60 for Limousin cross cows (119p/kg). All our cows were non FABBL today and were more difficult to place, unless at a fair discount – possibly 25p/kg in some cases.

It would pay 'hand over fist' to TB test these non-assured cows and sell them on a Friday store sale to other feeders or become assured.

70 CLEAN CATTLE

20 steers sold to av. 181p/kg – Ray Bason showed the way here selling to 239p/kg & 220p/kg for 566kg & 638kg respectively, with the Shropshire Jones selling 626kg Blondes to 210p/kg. Longhorn steer sold to 185p/kg from Mr Plant. More grass bullocks forward today.

58 heifers sold to av. 216p/kg – A superb tucked up Limousin 436kg from Steve Perkins sold to 256p/kg to steal the headlines, with other Limmies from Stuart Bebb and Roger Jordin selling to 250p/kg. Richard Parkes usual quality sold up to 248p/kg, with IGC Morris selling 610kg to £1409.10. Holstein free martins and young cows are included in this average.

58 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 170P/KG

Matt Bower's Limmies 656kg & 708kg sold to 215p/kg & 213p/kg with his 570kg handier weight selling to 212p/kg. Paul Taylor's run of 3 was headed by a handy weight Limousin 526kg sold at 215p/kg. There were less best sorts penned this morning.

Mary Beaumont's 512kg Friesian sold to 180p/kg with Holsteins selling to 167p/kg from the same home and Mike Evans. Montbeliardes sold to 179p/kg from Bill Rodenhurst.
