Prime Cattle Report (Red)

171 PRIME CATTLE

The most varied sample of cattle seen in Bridgnorth since last autumn! Good quality indoor fed beasts were very thing on the ground and trade butchers' orders difficult to fill. Runs if grass steers and heifers were more the order of the day, with few Continentals amongst them with many over 36 months. Our overall average was 191p/kg.

Heavy steers sold to 217p/kg for 748kg to add up to £1623.16. Many of our bullocks were dairy bred or over 36 months today. Best heifers met a flying trade with few of them below 500kg. 514kg British Blues sold to 268kg, with another to 260p/kg. Heavy females sold to £1589.28.

Bulls saw trade a little firmer but again many fell outside most abattoir requirements. Best sucklers topped at £1573.52 in the lump. Plenty of black and whites forward saw the best to 190p/kg.

24 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL SOLD TO AV. 108P/KG

Cow trade remains a little lack lustre but with few best cows forward. Meat Friesians sold to 137p/kg for 668kg from Chris & Robin Maydew, with 738kg Herefords to 137p/kg from James Lee. Hereford stock bulls also from the Lee stable also sold to 160p/kg for 1104kg.

104 CLEAN CATTLE

Only 15 steers sold to average 180p/kg. Phil Clarke's Simmental cross sold to 217p/kg for 748kg (£1623) with British Blue crosses to 209p/kg for 690kg from Phillip Terry whose Montbeliarde added up to £1503.48. 39 month Friesians sold to 161p/kg for 790kg from Mulberry Homes (indoor fed), with grass Charolais to the same for 752kg from Clive Edwards at 40 months. Many bullocks would have been better shown in the store sale!

89 heifers sold to average 200p/kg. A superb run from Matt Bower stole the headlines at 268p/kg, 260p/kg and 258p/kg for British Blues and Limousins. Mainly red Limousins from Roger Jordin sold passed 250p/kg on two occasions to a high of 254p/kg. Handy weight 452kg Continentals sold to 240p/kg from Miss Kirkham. Hereford crosses to 180p/kg from Julian Aston for 390kg.

60 YOUNG BULLS SOLD TO AV. 183P/KG

The above average includes 35 Holsteins, dairy breeds etc. and one bull 34mths of age. Andrew Preece (Cressage) sold his Limousins to 225p/kg for 636kg but was just pipped by Matt Parkes' Blonde making 228p/kg for 628kg. Andrew

did take third spot with a handy weight 538kg Limmie at 223p/kg. 712kg Limousins from Greg Thomas sold to 221p/kg (£1573.52).

Mulberry Homes headed the black and white section at 190p/kg for 690kg (£1311). Mark Beaumont's square Friesians, sold to 184p/kg for 504kg. Plain brethren at 50p/kg are included in the averages.
