Trade slightly improved but with more cattle forward to suit most buyers tastes. Once again cattle that were too lean or lacked shape more difficult to sell and were short of a few heavier cattle to fulfil regular orders. Cattle were a real credit to our producers which was commented on by the majority of buyers.

A small show of steers saw nicely shaped Continentals to 210p/kg or £1180 in the lump. A great heifer compliment saw 3 realise 243p/kg with the best at 244p/kg. Heavier heifers sold to £1316 in the lump.

Bull trade remained pretty static with Monday markets reporting depleted values. No bulls selling above 198p/kg today, with well finished Friesians doing nicely at 171p/kg. Heavy bulls sold ok to £1346.64. 2 cows forward saw Limousin x Speckled Parks selling to 80p/kg for 700kg.
