More clean cattle forward again which is great to see with plenty of buyers looking for cattle. Bulls were in shorter supply and saw trade as firm as last week. A firm trade on all shapes and sizes of clean cattle with some very lean sorts selling above expectation.

Similar steer numbers saw strong demand selling to a high of 226p/kg or to £1343 for non-assured Continentals. A sprinkling of Holsteins and over-weight cattle would sell in line with last week but would not help averages necessarily.

Butchers heifers sold to 244p/kg with several close behind, More second quality females found new homes easily.

Almost 20 more bulls were required today with six buyers attending. More demand on heavy bulls with handy-weights to 215p/kg with heavies to £1400. Friesian/Holsteins were easiest sold selling to 195p/kg. More well-finished bulls will be essential next week.

15 COWS sold to a steady trade with non-assured cows and small carcasses harder work. Well-fleshed 764kg Continentals to 127p/kg (£970), with black and white steakers to 99p/kg. Jerseys from 35p/kg to 48p/kg.

112 CLEAN CATTLE

23 steers sold to average 172p/kg – Limousins from a “very deserving cause” sold to 226p/kg and 220p/kg for tucked up cattle with 598kg Limmies to 214p/kg from David Chilton. Non-FABBL Continentals sold to £1343 and £1288 from Tim Kyte. Angus to 195p/kg. Holsteins very lean to 150p/kg.

89 heifers sold to av. 200p/kg – A super run from Richard Parkes sold to 244p/kg, 239p/kg and 237p/kg, with LH Wardle selling 508kg to 241p/kg with another to 235p/kg. Tom Baker and Henry Yates both achieved 237p/kg, with Andrew Dalton selling to 236p/kg.

44 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 170P/KG

A nice run of handy-weights from Paul Taylor were headed by his 490kg Limmies at 215p/kg, with Blues from Colin Evans to 195p/kg and 193p/kg.

Friesians sold to 195p/kg from the Evans stable with others from Mr Evans to 168p/kg, with Ed Bunning also to 168p/kg.

Best lambs over 200p/kg to 210p/kg for 40kg Texels from Peter Morris and a top price per head of £97 for 48kg at 202p/kg from Stuart Moss whose entry of Texels averaged 41.4kg and 201.5p/kg.

Generally finished lambs 38kg to 44kg over 170p/kg and heavier sorts 160p/kg plus although several of the top pens at 190p/kg, notably 46.5kg from Sam Jones.
