# BRIDGNORTH LIVESTOCK MARKET WEEKLY REPORT – 15.11.22



#### Auctioneer – Mark Burgoyne 07831 192603

An improved number forward this morning met a sharp trade, with any cattle with meat very well rewarded. More cattle could have easily sold today to a premium, with buyers looking to secure stocks as numbers remain tight.

A small sample of steers lacked any best types, but sold to 274p/kg or £1675 in the lump. More steers are needed each week.

Our heifer show was exceptional, with even some leaner types selling above expectation. Best butchers' animals topped at 335p/kg with 17 heifers selling to 300p/kg or above! Heavy females sold to a high of £1918 in the lump.

Bull trade was good and whilst not keeping up with the clean trade it was well in line with competition locally. Continentals sold to 264p/kg at 27 months or £1948 in the lump. Friesian bulls sold to 227p/kg.

Two cows sold to a high of 146p/kg for a lean 566kg Limmie from DO Jones.

## 52 CLEAN CATTLE

#### 5 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 248P/KG

Handyweight steers from Mr Jarvis topped at 274p/kg at 450kg, with heavier Blondes from Jones the Lowe selling to 265p/kg for 632kg. Other handyweight Limmies from Mr England sold to 256p/kg for 460kg, with Stabiliser crosses to 245p/kg from Mrs B.

#### 47 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 278P/KG

The usual cream from Evans Curdale sailed to 335p/kg for 544kg with others to 334p/kg, 332p/kg and 320p/kg (twice) from the same home. Very shapey but `quick' Blondes from Mrs B sold to a high of 328p/kg for 540kg with others to 324p/kg, 320p/kg, 319p/kg and 316p/kg. 528kg Limmies from Andrew Craig soared to 318p/kg with Richard Parkes selling his run to 314p/kg. Sam and Rob Jones got their Charolais cross females to stack up nicely at £1918, with Blues to £1889.66 from David Preece. 662kg fit Limmies sold to £1860.22 from Dave Jones.

#### 28 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 228P/KG

A run of three from Dave Jones sold to a high of 264p/kg at 738kg or £1948.32 in the lump. Other heavy Limousins from John Hewitt closely followed to 260p/kg and 256p/kg for 718kg and 734kg respectively.



Richard Price sold the best of his run to 255p/kg for 608kg.

Black & Whites bulls topped at 227p/kg from the returning Colin Evans, with another to 226p/kg for 520kg. A decent return on well-finished bulls whatever their shape.

A respectable overall average of 245p/kg, a little easier than last week, but that was always going to the case following an exceptional trade.

Best lambs topped at 290p/kg 39.5kg Beltex lambs from Pete Morris and 60kg Texels from Stuart Moss to just shy of £160.

As almost every week, butchers are keen to purchase quality and prepared to pay. Leaner, under-finished lambs remain hard work and would be much better presented in the store sale. As we approach the winter months it is important to mention that lambs which are presented clean and dry are selling to a premium, as opposed to wet, dirty sheep.

Lambs over 48kg were attracting interest, with lambs under 40kg selling to 255p/kg.

A very similar trade to last week with all of the meated stronger ewes attracting interest and plainer, ordinary ewes a selective trade.

No pure Continental ewes this week with cross-bred ewes to £153 for not the biggest, but quite shapey ewes, from Richie Morgan. Suffolk x Mules to £128 from Paul Taylor and a much better entry of North Country Mules sold to £110.

Large-framed, leaner ewes as dear as they have been for some weeks, with lean Continental X ewes £120 and Suffolks £100. Smaller, lean Mules £70 and hill ewes £50 for Scotch Blackface and £40 for Welsh.

Texel Rams sold to £121 and Cheviot Rams to £120. A tribe of goats sold to £65 for small Boers and £35 for a menagerie of lean, small, old Golden Guernseys and billy-goat-gruffs.


