WEEKLY REPORT – 16.02.16



161 PRIME CATTLE

A fair entry of cattle once again, with best sorts thinner on the ground. Although trade is nowhere near on fire, we saw a small improvement once again. Commercial cattle above 550kg without shape were the most difficult to sell but with lean, well-conformed and finished cattle easily placed.

More steers forward met a good trade throughout with the best to 230p/kg for 628kg (£1444.40).

Best butchers heifers fell just short of 250p/kg at 247p/kg, with several above 230p/kg. More handy-weight heifers are required.

Our bull entry was 80% Holstein today with hardly a suckler bull penned. The best Limousins sold to 211p/kg and two others above 200p/kg. There were no British Friesian black and whites, with Holsteins to 160p/kg, with well-finished dairy bulls easiest sold. More better quality bulls were desperately needed with buyers for these failing to fulfil orders.

31 COWS SOLD TO AV. 95.5P/KG

A tremendous cow entry with producers realising, at last, they do not have to leave the parish to have the price. There were no best suckler cows forward, with young but very lean cows to 135p/kg and fed Blondes to 125p/kg. Steaking Friesian Holsteins sold to 105p/kg for 806kg. One buyer left empty handed and as many or more cows will be essential next Tuesday.

109 CLEAN CATTLE

27 steers sold to av. 183p/kg – Frank Millichamp having been marginally disappointed with his lamb trade, left the market clicking his heels as his superb 628kg Blonde sold to 230p/kg (£1444.40) and his other steer to £1337. Handy-weights from Charlie Sandells to 209p/kg for 532kg. 618kg Limousins to 200p/kg from Alastair Beedles.

82 heifers sold to av. 187p/kg – The usual stamp from Richard Parkes headed the way at 247p/kg for 480kg, closely followed by Craig Evans and Alastair Beedles whose butchers beasts both achieved 246p/kg. 570kg Blondes from Brian Watkins sold to 241p/kg. Heavier Blondes to £1277.48 from the Millichamp stable once again. Bidding steady on more ordinary shapes.

52 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 160P/KG

A decent trade considering the distinct lack of shape available. Paul Taylor topped this department at 211p/kg for his 602kg Limousin. Limousins from Roger Tomley sold to 209p/kg for 568kg, with Gilbert Brown selling to 202p/kg for 580kg British Blue crosses.

578kg Holsteins to 160p/kg from Glyn Breeze, with 644kg to 158p/kg from David Preece. Robin & Chris Maydew saw their black and whites well over £1,000 mark.
