A few less clean cattle forward but this was complimented with more bulls penned this morning. Trade continues to hold up well with deadweight centres forced to 'up their game' by at least 5p/kg this week to compete with the live auctions. More quality handyweight cattle in evidence today helped to fill regular butcher's orders.

Some useful steers forward saw the best selling to 268p/kg with others to 256p/kg and £1518.48 top price in the lump.

Plenty of starring heifers sold to a high of 293p/kg with others to 290p/kg + 291p/kg. Not many heavy suckler heifers forward, hence a top price per head of £1605.64

Bull trade began the day on the front foot, with suckler bulls very thin on the ground selling to 236p/kg or £1524.24 in the lump. Plenty of Black and Whites forward met a roaring trade selling to 198p/kg. Lots of customers for bulls today.

Only two cows sold to a great trade of 153p/kg for 654kg for a British Blue cross that was farm assured.

Best hoggs to 339p/kg for Beltex from Hayden Woolley 41kg. A considerable number of butchers hoggs well over 310p/kg. Weight did not detract from the higher prices per kilo, with several pens of 46/47kg Texels realising around £150. Heavier more commercial hoggs 58kg at £142, with trade for heavier hoggs driven by a shortage, the current trade encouraging producers to sell at lighter weights.

Despite the average weight throughout the sale a little less than last week, the entire entry averaged ± 2 per head with more at ± 122.10 .

Lighter weights to 326p/kg for 33.5kg Beltex from Lee Preece, with Hill breeds 34kg at 296p/kg from Rob Rose and a consignment of 37kg hoggs from Gaz Davies £109 including Hannah's Herdwicks at £124.


