149 PRIME CATTLE

A good yard of meated cattle met a steady trade throughout, with the forthcoming bank holiday causing a little disruption to trade. Despite the increase in clean numbers, there were none too many smart butchers' heifers around the half ton mark. Consequently, best heifers held a firm trade throughout.

More steers than recent sales and a better show to boot. Shapey Continentals sold to 234p/kg, with heavies to £1298.

A real buzz on butchers' heifers selling to 252p/kg, with many just heavy enough to achieve top price per kilo. Heavy heifers coming to similar money to their male counterparts.

Fewer bulls forward with well-finished sorts easiest sold; anything too lean saw a severe price discount. Well-fleshed black and whites saw a dearer trade. Best Continentals sold to 221p/kg, with Friesians to 171p/kg.

3 COWS

3 cows sold to a useful trade. All Farm Assured entries this morning saw 748kg British Blues excelling for Frank Millichamp at 134p/kg.

108 CLEAN CATTLE

28 Steers sold to ov.av. 185p/kg – Superb Limmies from Andrew Craig took top spot at 235p/kg (£1372) with Johnnie Johnston's super run selling to 211p/kg for 604kg. Mrs Burgoyne and Gordon Jones both achieved 205p/kg for their Limmies. Blondes to £1298.80 from Frank Millichamp.

80 Heifers sold to ov.av. 196p/kg – Two storming Limousins from Richard Parkes sold to 252p/kg and 251p/kg around half a ton, closely followed by Dave Chilton selling similar weights to 249p/kg and 245p/kg. 486kg Blondes to 243p/kg from Roger Jordin.

41 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 172P/KG

Shapey Blondes from Brian & Dan Watkins sailed to 221p/kg for 562kg, with 546kg Limousins to 207p/kg from Bill Rodenhurst and family. 544kg Friesians sold to 171p/kg from Colin Evans. Plain sorts more difficult to place.

Another large entry of hogs with trade a little easier than the highs of last week but still very respectable averaging 211p/kg. Heavy hogs harder to sell with plenty of 43kg to 45kg sheep realising around £10 a head more than 50kg hogs/

Export and lighter weights selling well to 273p/kg for 37kg Beltex, lighter hill breeds 34kg Cheviots at 226p/kg and very ordinary 29kg at 218p/kg.

Generally 44kg around 200p/kg, with 46kg from Pete Levi at 230p/kg and heavy weights hard work to £95.20 from Roger Swift.
