137 PRIME CATTLE

A ring full of buyers but a small show of clean cattle resulted in a flying trade today. Some butchers left without fulfilling regular orders and competition for beasts was consequently strong. Clean cattle sold to average 204p/kg with an overall market average of 189p/kg including Holsteins, cattle over 30 months and out of spec sorts.

Low steers numbers forward saw a tremendous trade, with the best to 239p/kg with other 10-25p/kg dearer than a month ago. Heavy steers sold to £1450.

A very good show of butchers heifers sold to 239p/kg with many others over 230p/kg. Heavy females sold just of £1300 with commercial types much dearer.

Bull numbers helped fill the pens and saw a sharp trade and sold to 216p/kg or £1331 in the lump. Friesian/Holsteins in strong demand selling to 173p/kg.

18 COWS SOLD TO 114P/KG

An upturn in cow trade also, with only fat, non-assured cows difficult. British Blues 654kg topped ay 139p/kg with meated Friesians to 132p/kg for 618kg. 830kg Charolais (non-assured) sold to 130p/kg (£1079).

Many more cows and store bulls are needed with fresh orders operating today.

ONLY 67 CLEAN CATTLE

11 steers sold to av. 195p/kg – 584kg Limousins from the Kirton stable soared to 239p/kg with 656kg Limousins from Gerald Kincaid selling to 221p/kg. 616kg British Blue x Herefords sold to 216p/kg from Phil Clarke. 35m Longhorns to 172p/kg from Mr Plant.

56 heifers sold to average 206p/kg – 512klg Limousin from Neil Perkins topped here at 239p/kg, with cousin Steve selling to 237p/kg for 494kg Blues. Richard Parkes, Matt Bower and James Woolrich all sold to 235p/kg. Dave Preece's heavy Lims sold to £1297.

70 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 176P/KG

A super trade all round saw Roger Rowson selling 572kg Lims to 216p/kg closely followed by two from Andrew Baldwyn selling to 215p/kg. Richard Bebb and Tony Rochelle sold to 214p/kg with the Bebb stable achieving £1331. 542kg Friesians from Charlie Lloyd topped the black and whites at 173p/kg.
