A similar number of beasts penned this morning met a sharp trade being a shade dearer than last Tuesday. Once again, some tremendous finished cattle forward helping to fulfil regular orders. We require 100 clean and bulls every Tuesday with good buying support waiting.

Steers short in supply saw a high of 301p/kg or £2130 in the lump.

A 'snorting' heifer trade with a top call of 335p/kg with plenty past that 300p/kg barrier. Heavier females sold to £1904 in the lump.

Not quite the quality of bulls today with more out of the milking herd. A firm trade nevertheless resulted in a top of 295p/kg or £2367 for heavy weights.

Two meated cows forward sold to 223p/kg for 718kg Limousin cross.


